## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Unforgettable** Waves™: 3 (4, 5, 6) balls 3966 Spices

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6mm ΓUS J-101

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 11 dc = 4'' (10 cm); 6 rows = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Spiced Up Shoulder Cozy

Nice thing about shoulder cozies is that they can be worn wherever you need some warmth. Wear it over your head like a hood, around your neck like a cowl, or around your shoulders like a poncho. You'll love how nicely this yarn blends in with your wardrobe adding interesting texture and romantic style.

Directions are for size Small. Changes for sizes Medium, Large, and 1X are in parentheses.

Finished circumference at lower edge: 44 (48, 52, 56)" [112 (122,132, 142) cm]

#### Special Stitch

dc2tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## COZY

Ch 122 (132, 142, 152).

Round 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc) and in each ch across; taking care not to twist ch, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-120 (130, 140, 150) sts.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

Round 3: Repeat Round 2.

Round 4: Ch 1, sc in each st around: join with slip st in first sc.

Rounds 5-7: Repeat Round 2.

Round 8: Repeat Round 4.

Rounds 9-16: Repeat Rounds 5-8 twice.

Rounds 17 and 18: Repeat Round 2.

Round 19: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog, \*dc in next 3 sts, dc2tog; repeat from

\* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-96 (104, 112, 120) sts.

Round 20: Repeat Round 4.

Round 21: Ch 3, dc in next 5 sts, dc2tog,

\*dc in next 6 sts, dc2tog; repeat from

\* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-84 (91, 98, 105) dc.

Round 22: Repeat Round 2. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

With beginning tail, sew bottom edge of first and last sts of Round 1 together. Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**ch =** chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es);

\* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
