What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Swanky™:
2 balls 9101 Chiffon

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5.5mm [US I-9]

GAUGE: 4 shells = 4" (10 cm);
3 rows = 4" (10 cm) in V-st and
shells. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use
any size hook to obtain gauge.

Exquisite Tied Capelet

Use sequined yarn for an updated way to accessorize your look for day or evening. We've shown this capelet in a neutral shade, but it would look equally nice in any shade of this yarn.

SHOP KIT

Directions are for size Small. Changes for sizes Medium, Large, and X-Large are in parentheses.

Capelet measures 21 (23½, 26, 28½)" [53.5 (59.5, 66, 72.5) cm] at neck edge x 25 (28, 31, 34)" [63.5 (71, 78.5, 86.5) cm] at lower edge x 12 (13.5, 15, 16½)" [30.5 (33, 38, 42) cm] long.

Special Stitches

Shell = (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in indicated space.
V-st (V-stitch) = (Dc, ch 3, dc) in indicated stitch or space.

Notes

1. Capelet is made in rows. Edging is worked around 3 sides.
2. Capelet should drape comfortably around the neck and shoulder and is meant to gap slightly at the tie in the bust area.
3. To determine the best size, measure the wearer around arms and bust and subtract 20" (51 cm) from that measurement. Follow the size with the lower edge measurement that is closest to that number.

CAPELET

Ch 54 (60, 66, 72).

Row 1 (right side): Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn—53 (59, 65, 71 hdc).

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), *skip next st, V-st in next st; repeat from * 24 (27, 30, 33) times, skip next st, dc in last st, turn—25 (28, 31, 34) V-sts and 1 dc at each end.

Row 3: Ch 3, shell in ch-3 space of each V-st, dc in top of beginning ch, turn—25 (28, 31, 34) shells and 1 dc at each end.

Row 4: Ch 3, V-st in ch-1 space of each shell, dc in top of beginning ch, turn—25 (28, 31, 34) V-sts and 1 dc at each end.

Rows 5–16 (18, 20, 22): Repeat Rows 3 and 4 six (seven, eight, nine) times.

Row 17 (19, 21, 23): Repeat Row 3. Do not turn or fasten off.

Edging

Last Row (right side): Ch 1, working across ends of rows, work 2 sc in each row to first row, *sc in first row; ch 41, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across (tie made), sc in end of same row*; working in opposite side of foundation ch, sc in each ch across; working across ends of rows, repeat from * to * once; work 2 sc in ends of each remaining row; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—121 (135, 149, 163) sc and 2 ties. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses in same st; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
