## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver:**  
1 skein each 528 Medium  
Purple **A** and 3950 Charcoal **B**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 11 sts = 4" (10 cm) in herringbone double crochet and chain-1; 7 rows = 4" (10 cm) in herringbone double crochet. **CHECK YOUR**

**GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

**4** **RED HEART® Super Saver®**, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd (215 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins

# Herringbone Chevron Cowl

This interesting cowl combines two shades of yarn and features a herringbone stitch with chain spaces forming a zigzag lace pattern. You'll be amazed at how little you need to spend to crochet this fabulous wardrobe enhancer!

**Cowl measures 9" long x 60" in circumference (23 x 152.5 cm).**

## Special Stitch

**Herr dc (herringbone double crochet) =** Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, pull up a loop and draw through 1 loop on hook (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 1 loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops.

## Notes

1. Cowl is worked in joined rounds. There is no right or wrong side to this piece.
2. To change color, work to joining slip stitch at end of round. Insert hook in 3rd chain of beginning chain-4, yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

## COWL

With **A**, ch 180; taking care not to twist, join with slip st in first ch.

**Round 1:** Ch 4 (counts as first herr dc and ch-1 space here and throughout), skip next ch, herr dc in next 4 ch, \*ch 1, skip next ch, herr dc in next 4 ch; repeat from \* around to last 4 ch, ch 1, skip next ch, herr dc in last 3 ch; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch—144 herr dc and 36 ch-1 spaces.

**Round 2:** Slip st in first ch-1 space, ch 4, skip next dc, herr dc in next 3 dc, herr dc in next ch-1 space, \*ch 1, skip next dc, herr dc in next 3 dc, herr dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* to last 3 sts, skip next dc, herr dc in last 2 dc, herr dc in join of previous round; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

**Rounds 3 and 4:** Repeat Round 2; change to **B** at end of Round 4.

**Round 5:** Slip st in first ch-1 space, ch 4, turn, skip beginning ch, herr dc in next 3 dc, herr dc in next ch-1 space, \*ch 1, skip next dc, herr dc in next 3 dc, herr dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* to last 4 dc, ch 1, skip next dc, herr dc in last 3 dc; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

**Rounds 6–8:** Repeat Round 2; change to **A** at end of Round 8.

**Rounds 9–12:** Repeat Rounds 5–8; changing to **B** at end of Round 12.

**Rounds 13–16:** Repeat Rounds 5–8. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.



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
