What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 2 balls
9251 Coral

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 11 sts = 4" (10 cm) in herringbone double crochet and chain-1; 7 rows = 4" (10 cm) in herringbone double crochet. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

Chevron Herringbone Cowl

Choose a bright solid color yarn to show off the interesting herringbone stitch with chain spaces forming a zigzag lace pattern. This yarn feels smooth next to your skin for a cowl that is a joy to wear.

Cowl measures 8" long x 60" in circumference (20.5 x 152.5 cm).

Special Stitch

Herr dc (herringbone double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, pull up a loop and draw through 1 loop on hook (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 1 loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops.

Note

Cowl is worked in joined rounds. There is no right or wrong side to this piece.

COWL

Ch 180, taking care not to twist, join with slip st in first ch.

Round 1: Ch 4 (counts as first herr dc and ch-1 space here and throughout), skip next ch, herr dc in next 4 ch, *ch 1, skip next ch, herr dc in next 4 ch; repeat from * around to last 4 ch, ch 1, skip next ch, herr dc in last 3 ch; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch—144 herr dc and 36 ch-1 spaces.

Round 2: Slip st in first ch-1 space, ch 4, skip next dc, herr dc in next 3 dc, herr dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, herr dc in next 3 dc, herr dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * to last 3 sts, skip next dc, herr dc in last 2 dc, herr dc in join of previous round; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

Rounds 3-5: Repeat Round 2.

Round 6: Slip st in first ch-1 space, ch 4, turn, skip beginning ch, herr dc in next 3 dc, herr dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, herr dc in next 3 dc, herr dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * to last 4 dc, ch 1, skip next dc, herr dc in last 3 dc; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

Rounds 7-11: Repeat Rounds 3-6.

Rounds 12-15: Repeat Round 2.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
