RED HEART Mixology Prints ${ }^{\text {m"': }}$ 1 ball 931 Sizzling Print C RED HEART ${ }^{\ominus}$ Mixology Swirl ${ }^{\text {m': }}$ 1 ball 9931 Sizzling D

Susan Bates ${ }^{\bullet}$ Crochet Hook 11.5 mm [US P-16]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 7 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm}) ; 4$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. EXACT GAUGE IS NOT CRITICAL.

## Cowl measures 30 " ( 76 cm ) circumference and $71 / 2$ "

 ( 19 cm ) high.Note: Cowl is a crocheted rectangle; short ends of rectangle are sewn together to form Cowl.

## COWL

## With A, ch 14.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, [ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch] 6 times- 7 sc and 6 ch- 1 spaces.
Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, sc in first sc, [ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc] 6 times.
Fasten off.
Row 5 (right side): With right side facing, draw up a loop of $\mathbf{C}$ in first sc of previous row, ch 1 , working in front loops only, sc in same sc, [ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc] 6 times.
Rows 6-8: With C, repeat Rows 2-4. Fasten off.
Rows 9-32: Repeat Rows 5-8, changing color as in the
following sequence: Work next 4 rows with B, 4 rows with D, 4 rows with $\mathbf{A}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{C}, 4$ rows with $\mathbf{B}$, and 4 rows with $\mathbf{D}$. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## FINISHING

Sew the short edges together. Weave in ends
