What you will need:

RED HEART Mixology Solids": 1 ball each 631 Jade A and 862 Royal C RED HEART Mixology Prints": 1 ball 942 Calypso Print B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 16mm [US Q]

Large eye yarn or plastic needle

GAUGE: 6 sts = 4" (10 cm); 3 rows = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Color Block Cowl

Large coordinating blocks of color give this cowl an updated look. It's a super easy crochet project that won't take long to make!

Cowl measures 5½" wide x 68½" circumference (14 x 174 cm).

Notes

- 1. Cowl is worked back and forth in rows and then seamed across short ends.
- To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

COWL

With A, ch 9.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd chain from hook and in each ch across, turn—8 sc.
Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each st across, turn—8 dc.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 21" (53.5 cm); change to **B**.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 42" (106.5 cm); change to **C**.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 63" (160 cm); change to **B**.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 68.5" (174 cm). Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

With wrong sides held together, sew short ends together.
Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
