What you will need:

RED HEART® Grande Metallic™: 2 balls 1870 Vista

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 19mm [US Q].

Large eye yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.



RED HEART® Grande Metallic™, Art 826M available in 5.29 oz (150 g), 39 yd (36 m) balls



Horizontal Ribbed Cowl

Crochet this stunning cowl in little time thanks to the beautiful jumbo-size yarn. Choose the Grande with metallic for added dimension and anytime sparkle.

Cowl measures 8" (20.5 cm) wide x 32" (81.5 cm) circumference.

Special Stitches

Bpdc (back post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from back side of work to front and to back again around the post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook). Skip the stitch "in front of" the Bpdc.

Fpdc (Front post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook).

V-stitch (V-st) = (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in indicated stitch or space.

Notes

- Cowl is worked back and forth in rows then seamed.
- 2. When instructed to work into a V-st, work into the ch-1 space of the V-st.

COWL

Ch 13.

Row 1 (right side): Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch count as first dc), *skip next ch, V-st in next ch, skip next ch, dc in next ch; repeat from * once, dc in next ch, turn—4 dc and 4 V-sts.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), Bpdc around next dc, *V-st in next V-st, Bpdc around next dc; repeat from * once, dc in top of beginning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, Fpdc around next dc st, *V-st in next V-st, Fpdc around next dc; repeat from * once, dc in top of beginning ch, turn.

Rows 4-29: Repeat last 2 rows 13 times.

Row 30: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off leaving a 24" (61 cm) tail for sewing.

FINISHING

With wrong side of first and last rows together, whipstitch evenly to seam. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
