What you will need:

RED HEART® Boulevard™: 2 balls
5505 Atrium

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
19mm [US S]

Large eye yarn needle, stitch
marker

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for
this project.

Fabulous Fringe Cowl

*Here's a fun project that you can make this
afternoon and wear tonight thanks to the soft
jumbo weight yarn! Fringe edging is a fashionable
addition, and updates your style easily.*

**Cowl measures 7" (18 cm) wide x 30" (76
cm) circumference.**

Notes

1. Cowl is worked back and forth in rows
then seamed. Either side can be the right
side.
2. Fringes are added to front side of cowl.

COWL

Ch 14.

Row 1: Dc in 6th ch from hook (beginning
ch count as first skipped ch, dc, ch 1), *ch
1, skip next ch, dc in next ch; repeat from *
across, turn—6 dc and 5 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 2–20: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here),
*ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next dc;
repeat from * across, turn.
Fasten off leaving a 24" (61 cm) tail for
sewing.

FINISHING

Hold first and last rows together and
whipstitch evenly to seam. Weave in ends.
Fringe

Lay piece flat so seam is visible. Counting
ends of row, place stitch marker in 5th row
from seam. Cut 20 lengths of yarn each
measuring 14" (35.5 cm). Fold strand in half
to form a loop. Insert crochet hook from
front to back at marked row. Place fold on
hook and draw fold through, forming a loop.
Thread ends of strands through loop and
pull to tighten. Repeat to attach 2nd fringe
in same row. Working away from the seam,
repeat to attach 2 strands in each of next 9
rows. Trim ends evenly.

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; * = repeat
