## What you will need:

**Red Heart® Boutique Unforgettable®:** 1 ball 3932 Springtime

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 6mm [US]-10]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 2 pattern repeats = 4" (10 cm) (one pattern repeat consists of one shell and one single crochet); 8 rows = 4" (10 cm) in shell pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Le Papillon Cowl

*Bobbles and shells are combined to form a textural butterfly pattern in this standout cowl. The soft tonal quality of this shaded yarn is perfect for showing off your pretty crochet stitches.*

**Cowl measures 9½" wide x 30" circumference (24 x 76 cm).**

## Special Stitches

**bobble** = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, [yarn over, insert hook in same stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] 4 times, yarn over and draw through 11 loops on hook.

**shell** = 5 dc in indicated stitch.

## Special Technique

**Join with sc** = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

## Notes

- Each side of cowl is worked back and forth in rows from both edges of center foundation row.
- Short edges of rows are sewn together to form cowl.

## COWL

Ch 92.

**Foundation Row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—91 sc.

## First Side

**Row 1 (right side):** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*bobble in next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* across, turn—45 bobbles and 46 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn—91 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*skip next 2 sc, shell in next sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* across, turn—15 shells and 16 sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in first sc, \*sc in center dc of next shell, shell in next sc; repeat from \* across to last shell, sc in center dc of last shell, 3 dc in last sc, turn—14 shells, 15 sc, and 3 dc at each end.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first dc, shell in next sc, \*sc in center dc of next shell, shell in next sc; repeat from \* across to last 3 dc, skip next 2 dc, sc in last dc, turn—15 shells and 16 sc.

**Rows 6–11:** Repeat Rows 4 and 5 three times. Fasten off.

## Second Side

**Row 1 (wrong side):** With wrong side of Foundation Row facing and working in opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with sc in first ch, \*skip next 2 ch, shell in next ch, skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from \* across, turn—15 shells and 16 sc.

**Rows 2–9:** Repeat Rows 4 and 5 of first side 4 times.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## FINISHING

Working across ends of rows, sew short edges together. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
