What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
2 skeins 3953 Butterfly

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4"; 8 rows =
4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE. Use any size hook to
obtain the gauge.**

Rev Up the Color Cowl

Brighten up the cloudy days of winter with this easy cowl in a bright multi-colored yarn. This is the perfect quick project for adding to your wardrobe of warm accessories or for gift giving!

Cowl measures 8 x 60" (20 x 152 cm)

NOTE

Cowl is worked lengthways back and forth with seam sewn at short ends to form circle.

COWL

Row 1 (Right Side): Ch 153.

In 4th ch from hook and every ch across, make 1 dc. Ch 3 turn. (150 dc)

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Ch 3 counts as first dc, skip first dc, dc in every dc across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 3: Sc in every dc across, ch 1, turn. (150 sc):

Row 4: Sc in every ch across. Ch 3, turn. (150 sc)

Row 5: Ch 3 counts as first dc, skip first sc, dc in every remaining sc. Ch 3, turn.

Row 6: Same as Row 2.

Rows 7-14: Repeat rows 3-6 twice.

Rows 15-16: Repeat rows 3-4 once. Fasten off.

FINISHING

With right sides facing, align row ends and sew seam with yarn tail to form circle. Weave in ends. Wrap around neck twice to wear.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **double mm** = millimeters;
sc = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es)
