## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Grande™:** 6 balls  
307 Oatmeal

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
16 mm [US Q]

Large eye yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 4 sc = 3¾" (9.5 cm); 4  
rows = 3½" (9 cm). **CHECK YOUR  
GAUGE. Use any size hook to  
obtain the gauge.**

# Back to Scotland Cowl

*Go back to Scotland or around your hometown in a cowl that will keep you wonderfully warm. The repeated pattern and thick yarn make it quick to crochet.*

SHOP KIT

**Cowl measures 24" wide x 56" circumference (61 x 142 cm).**

## Notes

1. Cowl is worked in joined rounds with right side facing.
2. You may prefer to use a crochet hook to weave in ends.

## COWL

Ch 61.

**Round 1 (right side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; join with slip st in first sc—60 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 3, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* around, ch 3, skip last 2 sc; join with slip st in first sc— 20 sc and 20 ch-3 spaces.

**Round 3:** Slip st in first ch-3 space, ch 1, 3 sc in same space and in each ch-3 space around; join with slip st in first sc— 60 sc.

**Rounds 4–27:** Repeat Rounds 2 and 3 twelve times.  
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
