## What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique  
Unforgettable™: 1 ball 9942  
Cappuccino

Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks:  
4.25 mm [US G-6].

Yarn Needle

**GAUGE:** 4 rows = 2 1/2" (6.5 cm);  
Row 8 = 7" (18 cm) wide. **CHECK  
YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook  
to obtain the gauge given.

# Flowered Cowl

*Shells and V-stitches are combined for a feminine take on the cowl. The loop at one end cleverly goes around the "Flower" button at the other end.*

**Cowl measures: 7" (18 cm) wide x 30" (76 cm) long, excluding flower**

## Special Stitches Used

**V-st:** (Dc, ch 1, dc) in same st.

**shell:** 5 dc in same st or space.

**single crochet 2 together (sc2tog)** = [Insert hook in next st, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## COWL

Ch 9.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—8 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc across, turn—16 sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 5:** Repeat Row 3—32 sc.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across, turn—33 sc.

**Row 7:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1, here and throughout), dc in first sc (counts as first V-st), \*skip next 3 sc, shell in next sc, skip next 3 sc, V-st in next sc; repeat from \* across, turn—5 V-sts; 4 shells.

**Row 8:** Ch 3 (counts as dc, here and throughout), 2 dc in next ch-1 space (half shell made), \*skip next 3 dc, V-st in next dc (center dc of shell)\*\*, shell in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* across, ending last repeat at \*\*, 3 dc in last ch-1 space (half shell made), turn—4 V-sts; 3 shells; 2 half shells.

**Row 9:** Ch 4, dc in first dc, \*shell in next ch-1 space, skip next 3 dc, V-st in next dc; repeat from \* across, turn—5 V-sts; 4 shells.

**Rows 10-56:** Repeat Rows 8-9 (23 times); then repeat Row 8.

**Row 57:** Ch 1, sc in each dc and ch-1 space across, sc in top of turning ch, turn—33 sc.

**Row 58:** Ch 1, sc2tog over first 2 sc, sc in each sc across, turn—32 sc.

**Row 59:** Ch 1, \*sc2tog over next 2 sts; repeat from \* across, turn—16 sts.

**Row 60:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 61:** Repeat Row 59—8 sts.

**Rows 62-63:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn

**Row 64 (button loop):** Ch 12, skip first 7 sc, slip st in last sc of Row 63, turn.

**Row 65:** Ch 1, sc in each of next 12 ch sts; join with a slip st in last sc of Row 63. Fasten off.

## FLOWER (button)

Ch 4; join with a slip st in first ch.

**Round 1:** Ch 1, 12 sc in ring; join with a slip st in front loop of first sc—12 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, working in front loops only, (sc, hdc) in first sc, \*(hdc, sc) in next sc\*\*, (sc, hdc) next sc; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*; join with a slip st in remaining back loop of first sc in round below—6 petals.

**Round 3:** Ch 1, working behind Round 2 in back loops only of sts in Round 1, 2 sc in each sc around; join with a slip st in front loop of first sc—24 sc.

**Round 4:** Repeat Round 2—12 petals.

**Round 5:** Ch 1, working in back loops only of sts in Round 3, sc in each sc around; join with a slip st in front loop of first sc—24 sc.

**Round 6:** Ch 1, hdc in first sc, \*2 dc next sc, hdc in next sc, ch 1\*\*, (slip st, ch 1, hdc) next sc; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*; join with a slip st in remaining back loop of first sc in round below.

**Round 7:** Working in back loops only of sts in Round 5, repeat Round 6. Fasten off. Sew flower in place at beginning end of scarf.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\* or \*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
