14 sc and 15 rows $=4$ " [10 cm].
Motif = Approx $61 / 4\left(7^{11 / 2-83 / 4}-101 / 2\right)^{1}$ [16 (19-22-26.5) cm] square.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

SQUARE I
MAKE 8 (8-8-7)
Color 1 = A
Color $2=\mathrm{E}$
Color $3=\mathrm{B}$
Color $4=\mathrm{F}$

## SQUARE II

MAKE 8 (8-8-6)
Color 1 = A
Color $2=\mathrm{G}$
Color $3=$ D
Color 4 = C

## SQUARE III

MAKE 7 (7-7-6)
Color 1 = A
Color 2 = F
Color 3 = D
Color $4=\mathrm{G}$

## SQUARE IV

MAKE 7 (7-7-5)
Color 1 = A
Color $2=\mathrm{C}$
Color $3=\mathrm{B}$
Color $4=\mathrm{E}$

## Notes:

- Ch 2 at beg of rnd does not count as st.
- Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as dc.
- Ch 6 at beg of rnds counts as dc and ch-3 sp.
- Join all rnds with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-6 unless otherwise indicated.


## Size XS/S only - Stripe Pat

With Color 1, work 1 rnd. With Color 2, work 1 rnd. With Color 3, work 1 rnd. With Color 4, work 1 rnd. With Color 1, work 1 rnd.

## Size M/L only - Stripe Pat

With Color 1, work 1 rnd. With Color 2, work 1 rnd. With Color 3, work 1 rnd. With Color 4, work 1 rnd. With Color 2, work 1 rnd. With Color 1, work 1 rnd.

Size XL/2XL only - Stripe Pat
With Color 1, work 1 rnd. With Color 2, work 1 rnd. With Color 3, work 1 rnd. With Color 4, work 1 rnd. With Color 2, work 1 rnd. With Color 3, work 1 rnd. With Color 1, work 1 rnd.

## Size 3/4/5XL only - Stripe Pat

With Color 1, work 1 rnd. With Color 2, work 1 rnd. With Color 3, work 1 rnd. With Color 4, work 1 rnd. With Color 2, work 1 rnd. With Color 3, work 1 rnd. With Color 4, work 1 rnd. With Color 1, work 1 rnd.

## MOTIF

With Color 1, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring. See diagram on page 3.
1st rnd: (RS). Ch 6. (3 dc in ring. Ch 3) 3 times. 2 dc in ring. Join. Fasten off. 12 dc and $4 \mathrm{ch}-3$ sps. First rnd of Stripe Pat is now in position.
2nd rnd: Join Color 2 in any ch-3 sp. Ch 6.3 dc in same ch-3 sp. *Ch 1. ( 3 dc . Ch 3.3 dc ) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from *twice. Ch 1.2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join. Fasten off. $24 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}-1$ sps and $4 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$.
3rd rnd: Join Color 3 in any ch-3 sp. Ch 6.3 dc in same ch-3 sp. *Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3.3 dc ) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1.3 dc in last ch-1sp. Ch 1.2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join. Fasten off. 36 dc, 8 ch- 1 sps and $4 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$.

4th rnd: Join Color 4 in any ch-3 sp. Ch 6.3 dc in same ch-2 sp. *(Ch 1. 3 dc ) in each ch-1 sp across to next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3.3 dc ) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * twice. (Ch 1.3 dc ) in each ch-1 sp across to first ch-3 sp. Ch 1.2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join. Fasten off. $48 \mathrm{dc}, 12 \mathrm{ch}-1$ sps and 4 ch- 3 sps.

## 5th rnd: As 4th rnd.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep 5th rnd 0 (1-2-3) time(s) more. Fasten off.

Front and Back Panels: Following Diagrams (see page 5), sew Motifs tog with A through back loops only using whipstitch as shown here in video tutorial.

## FRONT

With RS facing, join A with sl st to top right corner of Front Panel.
1st row: (RS). Ch 2. Work 65 (79-91111) hdc evenly across. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 63 (77-89-109) sts.

## Shape Left Front

1st row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each of next 17 (21-25-27) sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in next st. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked. 21 (25-29-31) sts.
2nd to 7th rows: Ch 2.1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 9 (13-17-19) sts at end of 7th row. Fasten off.

## Shape Right Front

With RS facing, skip next 17 (23-2743) hdc. Join A with sl st to next hdc. 1st row: Ch 2.1 hdc in same st as last sl st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each of next 17 (21-25-27) hdc. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 21 (25-2931) sts.

2nd to 7th rows: Ch 2.1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 9 (13-17-19) sts at end of 7 th row. Fasten off.

## BACK

With RS facing, join A with sl st to top right corner of Back Panel.
1st row: (RS). Ch 2. Work 65 (79-91111) hdc evenly across. Turn.

2nd to 5th rows: Ch 2.1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 57 (71-83-103) sts at end of 5th row.

## Shape Right Back

1st row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each of next 9 (13-17-19) hdc. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in next st. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked. 13 (17-21-23) sts.
2nd and 3rd rows: Ch 2.1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 9 (13-17-19) sts at end of 3rd row. Fasten off.

## Shape Left Back

With RS facing, skip next 27 (33-3753) hdc. Join A with sl st to next hdc. 1st row: Ch 2.1 hdc in same st as last sl st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each of next 9 (13-17-19) hdc. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 13 (17-21-23) sts.
2nd and 3rd rows: Ch 2.1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 9 (13-17-19) sts at end of 3rd row. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

PM 8 (9-10-11)" [20.5 (23-25.5-28) cm ] on each side of Front and Back down from shoulders. Sew side seams.
Neck edging: (RS). Join A with sl st to neck edge at shoulder seam. Work 1 rnd of sc evenly around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off. PM at center front neck edge.

Collar: With RS facing, join F with sl st at center front neck edge marker.
1st row: Ch 2 . Work 1 hdc in each st around neck edging. PM on each st at side seam and PM at center back. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts. ( 1 hdc in each st to 1 st before marked st. 2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in marked st. 2 hdc in next st) 3 times. 1 hdc in each st to last 5 sts. 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn.
3rd row: As 2nd row. Fasten off.

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
