



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Beginning
Ch(s) = Chain(s)
Pat = Pattern
PM = Place marker
Rep = Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet
Scbl = Single crochet through back loop only
Sl st = Slip stitch
Sp(s) = Sp(s)
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Finished Circumference: Approx **20½ (22-24)" 52 (56-61)** cm.

GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Notes: Join all rnds with sl st to first sc.

To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.

With B, ch **66 (72-78)**, making sure ch is not twisted. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.

1st rnd: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in same ch as joining and in each ch around. Join with sl st into back loop of first sc. Turn. **66 (72-78)** sts.

2nd rnd: (WS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc around. Join A. Turn. Break B.

3rd rnd: (RS). With A, ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc around. Join. Turn.

4th rnd: (WS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st around. Join C. Turn. Break D.

5th to 6th rnds: With C, rep 3rd to 4th rnds.

MATERIALS

Red Heart® "Super Saver"™ (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Sizes	S	M	L	
Contrast A Cherry Red (0332)	1	1	1	ball
Contrast B Med. Purple (0528)	1	1	1	ball
Contrast C Carrot (0256)	1	1	1	ball
Contrast D Lt. Raspberry (0774)	1	1	1	ball

Sizes U.S I/9 [5.5 mm] crochet hook **or sizes needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch markers. Yarn needle.

7th to 8th rnds: With D, rep 3rd to 4th rnds.

9th to 10th rnds: With B, rep 3rd to 4th rnds. Join A at end of last rnd.

11th rnd: (RS). With A, ch 1. *Working through both loops*, 1 sc in each st around. Join. PM for beg of rnd. **Do not** turn.

12th to 17th rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join B at end of last rnd. Break D.

18th rnd: With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *Insert hook in next sc 3 rows below. Yoh and draw up a loop, maintaining length of st. Yoh and draw through both loops on hook* – point made. *1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Point in next st. Rep from * around. Join. Turn.

19th to 21st rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join. Turn. Join D at end of last rnd.

22nd to 23rd rnds: With D, ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join. Turn. Join C at end of last rnd.

24th to 25th rnds: With C, ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join. Turn. Join A at end of last rnd.

26th to 29th rnds: (RS). With C, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join. PM for beg in rnd. **Do not** turn. Join D at end of last rnd.

30th rnd: (RS). With D, as 18th rnd.

31st rnd: (WS). With D, ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join B at end of last rnd. Turn.

32nd to 33rd rnds: With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join. Turn. Join C at end of last rnd.

34th to 35th rnds: With C, ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join. Turn. Join A at end of last rnd.

36th to 37th rnds: With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join. Turn. Fasten off at end of last rnd.

FINISHING

Closing: Count **11 (12-13)** sts from join. PM. Skip next **22 (24-26)** sts. PM. Skip next **22 (24-26)** sts. PM. [Attach D in marked st, ch 1. Fold hat with ch in corner. *Working through both thicknesses*, 1 sc in each of first **11 (12-13)** sts. Fasten off] 3 times.

Edging-Rnd 1: Join D with sl st at first foundation ch. Ch 1. *Working through rem loops of foundation chain*. 1 sc in each st around. Join. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
