## What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Unforgettable Waves™: 2 balls 3990 Menagerie

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

**Hat circumference:** 20" [51 cm]

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in slip stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Upscale Slouchy Hat

The beautiful shadings combine with the thick-and-thin weight of this yarn for a wonderful texture. You'll love having this crocheted hat to accessorize your look and brighten even a dreary day.

#### One size fits most

#### **NOTES**

Brim is worked in rows and then joined to make a loop to fit around head. Stitches are picked up along one long edge and are worked in joined rounds to top of crown.

#### **SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS**

**dc2tog:** [Yarn over, insert hook in next ch-1 space of V-st, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all loops on hook

**V-Stitch:** (Dc, ch 1, dc) all in the same st.

## **HAT**

### Brim

Ch 9.

**Row 1:** Slip st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 8 sts.

**Rows 2-100:** Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, slip st in each st across.

Joining Row: Ch 1, turn, with wrong sides facing and right sides rows together, fold band in half to line up sts of first and last rows, working through both layers, sc in each st across to join ends.

Turn Brim right side out.

## **Body**

**Round 1:** Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1 here and throughout), dc in same st, [skip 3 rows, V-st in next row] around, slip st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4-25 V-sts.

Rounds 2-14: Ch 4, dc in ch-1 space, [V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st] around, slip st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.
Shape Crown

**Round 15:** Ch 3, [dc2tog in ch-1 space of next 2 V-sts] 12 times. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.



## **FINISHING**

Weave long tail through sts of last row and pull to close top of crown. Secure end. Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together;
 ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
