# What you will need:

RED HEART® Heads Up™: 1 (2) ball(s) 801 Sky

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [K-10.5 US]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 7 sts = 3" (7.5 cm) in pattern; Rounds 1 and 2 = 3" (7.5 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Heads Up, Art E821 available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 106 yd (97 m) balls



# Basketweave Hat

Here's a great crochet hat to warm you wherever your travels may take you. It's the perfect gender neutral style for all ages!

Directions are for size Women's Small. Changes for size Women's Large are in parentheses.

Hat measures 20 (22)" [51 (56) cm] circumference at brim.

## **Special Stitches**

**bpdc** (back post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from back side of work to front and to back again around the post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook). Skip the stitch in front of the bpdc.

**fpdc** (Front post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook). Skip the stitch behind the fpdc.

**bpslip st** (back post slip stitch) = Insert hook from back side of work to front and to back again around the indicated chains; yarn over and draw through loop on hook.

**fpslip st** (front post slip stitch) = Insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around the indicated chains; yarn over and draw through loop on hook.

#### **Notes**

Hat is worked in joined rounds. Some rounds are joined with front post or back post slip stitch.

#### HAT

from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc); join with slip st in top of beginning ch—12 dc. Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in same st as joining, 2 dc in each remaining st; join with slip st in top of

Round 1 (right side): Ch 4, 11 dc in 4th ch

beginning ch—24 dc.

Round 3: Ch 3, dc in same st as joining,
dc in next st, \*2 dc in next st, dc in next st;
repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of
beginning ch—36 dc.

## **Size Small only**

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in same st as joining, dc in next 2 sts, \*2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts; repeat from \* around; join with fpslip st around beginning ch—48 dc.

## **Size Large only**

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in same st as joining, dc in next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, \*dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st; repeat from \* around to last 2 sts, dc in last 2 sts; join with fpslip st around beginning ch—54 dc.

#### **Both sizes**

**Round 5:** Ch 3, fpdc around next 2 sts, bpdc around next 3 sts, \*fpdc around next 3 sts, bpdc around next 3 sts; repeat from \* around; join with bpslip st around beginning ch.

Round 6: Ch 3, bpdc around next 2 sts, fpdc around next 3 sts, \*bpdc around next 3 sts, fpdc around next 3 sts; repeat from \* around; join with fpslip st around beginning ch.

**Round 7–12:** Repeat Rounds 5 and 6 three times.

Round 13: Repeat Round 5, turn.

Round 14 (wrong side): Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.
