## What you will need:

Red Heart® Boutique Unforgettable™: 1 ball 3955 Winery.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6mm [J-10 US]

Yarn needle

GAUGE:  $14 \text{ sts} = 4^{\circ} (10 \text{ cm})$  in pattern;  $8 \text{ rounds} = 4^{\circ} (10 \text{ cm})$ . CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Slouchy Beanie

Starting at the top, this beanie is crocheted in the round using post stitches for a ribbed effect. Choose any shade of this beautiful yarn for a hat you'll love giving, or wearing yourself! Hat measures approximately 18" (45.5 cm) circumference at brim

### **Special Stitches**

BPdc (back post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from back to front and then to back again around post of next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

BPhdc (back post half double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from back to front and then to back again around post of next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

BPdc2tog (back post double crochet decrease) = [Yarn over, insert hook from back to front and then to back again around post of next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

hdc2tog (half double crochet decrease) = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop] 2 times, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook.

reverse sc (reverse single crochet) = Work single crochet in opposite direction from which you would usually work (left to right if you are right-handed and right to left if you are left-handed). This stitch is also known as crab stitch.

#### Notes

- Hat is worked in continuous rounds from top down with right side facing at all times.
   Do not turn rounds.
- 2. Repeat Round 3 for all odd-numbered Rounds 5-31; instructions are written for all even-numbered rounds and Round 33.

## HAT

Ch 5, join with slip st in first ch to form ring. **Round 1:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 11 dc into ring; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—12 dc.

**Round 2:** Ch 3, dc in same st as joining, 2 dc in each st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—24 dc.

Round 3 and all odd-numbered rows through

**Round 31:** Ch 3, work BPdc in each st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3.

Round 4: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), 2 hdc in next st, \*hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2—36 hdc.

**Round 6:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, \*hdc in next 2 st, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2—48 hdc.

**Round 8:** Ch 2, hdc in next 2 st, 2 hdc in next st, \*hdc in next 3 st, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2—60 hdc.

Round 10: Ch 2, hdc in next 3 st, 2 hdc in next st, \*hdc in next 4 st, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2—72 hdc.

Round 12: Ch 2, hdc in next 4 st, 2 hdc in next st, \*hdc in next 5 st, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2—84 hdc.

Round 14: Ch 2, hdc in next 5 st, 2 hdc in next st, \*hdc in next 6 st, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2—96 hdc.

Round 16: Ch 2, hdc in next 6 st, 2 hdc in next st, \*hdc in next 7 st, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2—108 hdc.

Rounds 18, 20, and 22: Ch 2, hdc in each st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2.

Round 24: Ch 2, hdc2tog in next st, \*hdc in next st, hdc2tog in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2—72 st.

Round 26: Repeat Round 3.

**SHOP KIT** 



Round 28: Ch 3, BPdc in next 6 st, BPdc2tog in next st, \*BPdc in next 7 st, BPdc2tog in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—63 dc.

Rounds 30 and 32: Repeat Round 3.

Round 33: Ch 2, BPhdc in each st; join with

slip st in top of beginning ch-2.

**Round 34:** Ch 1, reverse sc in each st; join with slip st in first st. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
