What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 316 Black A and 3620 Glowworm B

Susan Bates ® Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 12 sts and 12 rows ribbing = 4" (10cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Hats-a-Glow

Sport a neon yarn color with black for an energized, bold new look. But, of course, you can choose to crochet this hat in any of the many colors of Super Saver yarn!

Directions are for size to fit Teens. Changes for size to fit Adult are in parentheses.

Hat measures 20 (22)" [51 (56) cm] circumference.

Notes

- 1. Ribbing is worked first. Hat is worked in turned rows then back seam is sewn.
- To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Carry old color loosely up side of piece until next needed.

Special Stitches

dc2tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] 2 times, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

HAT Ribbing

With A, ch 6.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across – 5 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in back loops of each st across.

Rows 3-59 (65): Repeat Row 2. Do not fasten off.

Body

Row 1 (Right Side): Ch 1, rotate to work into row ends, work 60 (66) sc evenly along row ends of ribbing -60 (66) sts. Fasten off **A**.

Row 2: With Right Side facing, join **B** with sc in first st of Row 1, sc in each remaining st across.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across, changing to **A** in last st.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, skip first st, dc in each remaining st across.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, skip first st, dc in each remaining st across, changing to **B** in last st.

Rows 6-7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across, changing to **A** in last st of Row 7.

Rows 8-9: Repeat Rows 4-5.

Rows 10- 11: Repeat Rows 6-7.

Row 12: With **A**, ch 3, turn, skip first st, dc in next 3 sts, dc2tog, [dc in next 4 dc, dc2tog] 9 (10) times -50 (55) sts.

Row 13: Ch 3, turn, skip first st, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog, [dc in next 3 dc, dc2tog] 9 (10) times, changing to **B** in last st – 40 (44) sts.

Row 14: Ch 1, turn, [sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 10 (11) times – 30 (33) sts.

Row 15: Ch 1, turn, [sc in next sc, sc2tog] 10 (11) times, changing to $\bf A$ in last st - 20 (22) sts.

Row 16: Ch 1, turn, [sc2tog] 10 (11) times – 10 (11) sts.

Row 17: Ch 1, turn, [sc2tog] 5 times, (sc in last st) – 5 (6) sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

SHOP KIT



FINISHING

Weave yarn tail through sts of Row 17 and pull to close tightly. Fasten securely. With Right Sides facing, align row ends and sew back seam. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C etc; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
