What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein of 726 Coral

Susan Bates[®] Crochet Hook: 5 mm [US H-8] and 6 mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

 $\begin{array}{l} \mbox{GAUGE: Rounds $1-3=3.5" (9 cm),} \\ \mbox{with smaller size hook. CHECK} \\ \mbox{YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook} \\ \mbox{to obtain the gauge.} \end{array}$

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather, and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yd (238 m) skeins



Judy's Hat

This comfy crocheted hat looks great on all ages, so we've included the smaller size for younger females. Add a matching flower for a bit of style. Hat directions are written for size Medium (Child's) with changes for size Large (Women's) in parentheses.

Finished Hat Size: 20 (22)" (51 (56) cm) head circumference

HAT

Round 1 (Right side): With smaller size hook, ch 4; 11 dc in fourth ch from hook (skipped chs count as first dc), join with slip st to first dc: 12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), dc in same dc, 2 dc in each dc around; join with slip st to first dc: 24 dc. **Round 3:** Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in next dc, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, dc in next dc) around; join with slip st to first dc: 36 dc.

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in next 2 dc, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc) around; join with slip st to first dc: 48 dc.

Round 5: Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc) around; join with slip st to first dc: 60 dc.

Size Medium Only

Rounds 6-11: Ch 3, dc in each dc around; join with slip st to first dc.

Round 12: With larger size hook, ch 6 (counts as first dc plus ch-3 sp), dc in next dc, (ch 3, dc in next dc) around, ch 3; join with slip st to first dc: 60 dc and 60 ch-3 sps. Round 13: Ch 3, (skip next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc) around; join with slip st to first dc. Rounds 14 and 15: Ch 3, dc in each dc around; join with slip st to first dc; fasten off.

Size Large Only

Round 6: Ch 3, dc in same dc, dc in next 4 dc, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc) around; join with slip st to first dc: 72 dc. Rounds 7-12: Ch 3, dc in each dc around; join with slip st to first dc. **Round 13:** With larger size hook, ch 6 (counts as first dc plus ch-3 sp), dc in next dc, (ch 3, dc in next dc) around, ch 3; join with slip st to first dc: 72 dc and 72 ch-3 sps. **Round 14:** Ch 3, (skip next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc) around; join with slip st to first dc. **Rounds 15 and 16:** Ch 3, dc in each dc around; join with slip st to first dc; fasten off.

FLOWER

Round 1 (Right side): With smaller size hook, ch 4; 11 dc in fourth ch from hook (skipped chs count as first dc), join with slip st to first dc: 12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in next dc, (ch 7, sc in next dc) around, ch 7; join with slip st to first sc; fasten off.

FINISHING

Thread yarn needle with a length of yarn. Using photo as a guide, sew wrong side of Flower to right side of Hat.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeter; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeter; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses as indicated.
