What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love
Chunky™**: 2 balls 1939 Papaya

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
8mm [US L-11] and 10mm [US
N/P-15]

3¾" (85mm) diameter
pompom maker (optional),
yarn needle

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" (10 cm); 8
rows = 4" (10 cm) in crossed
sc with larger hook. **CHECK
YOUR GAUGE. Use any size
hook to obtain the gauge.**

Cute Crochet Hat

A simple and fun chunky crochet hat is given a boost of texture with crossed single crochet while being worked in rows!

Directions are for size **Small/Medium**.
Changes for size **Large/X-Large** are in
parentheses.

To fit head circumference: 20 (22)" [51
(56) cm]

Finished circumference: 19¼ (20)" [49
(51) cm]

Notes

Brim is worked side to side and seamed.
Hat is worked in joined rounds from
brim to crown.

Special Abbreviations

blo = work in back loop only of
indicated stitch

sc2tog (single crochet decrease):
[Insert hook into next stitch and pull
up a loop] twice; yarn over and draw
through all three loops on hook - 1
stitch decreased.

HAT Brim

With smaller hook, ch 9.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in
each ch across, turn - 8 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in blo in each st across,
turn.

Repeat Row 2 forty-six (forty-eight)
more times.

Bring short ends of Brim together. Sc
across short ends, stitching through
both ends at the same time to seam.
Do not fasten off.

Body

Change to larger hook.

Round 1: Ch 1, sc in each Brim row end
around; join with a slip st to first sc, turn
- 48 (50) sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, *skip next sc, sc in next
sc, sc in previous skipped sc; repeat
from * around, join with a slip st to 1st
sc, turn.

Repeat Round 2 until hat measures 7"
(17.75 cm) long.



Crown Decreases

Round 1: Ch 1, *sc2tog, [skip next sc, sc
in next sc, sc in previous skipped sc]
two (three) times, sc2tog; repeat from *
around, join with a slip st to 1st sc, turn -
12 (10) sts dec, 36 (40) sts total.
Repeat Round 1 two (three) more times
- 12 (10) sts.

Fasten off, leaving a 6" (15 cm) yarn tail.

FINISHING

Thread yarn through yarn needle and
draw through remaining sts twice; draw
up firmly and fasten securely.

Optional: Using pompom maker, make
pompom and attach securely.

With yarn needle, weave in all loose
ends. Wash and lay flat to block.
