# MAKE THIS

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED



## GAUGE

8 **double crochet** (dc) and 5 rows = 4" [10 cm] with 2 strands of yarn held together.



## YARN

- **Red Heart® Super Saver®**  
(7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

## COLORS

### Quantity

- **Contrast A** Black (0312)  
2 balls or 530 yds/482 m
- **Contrast B** Soft White (0316)  
1 ball or 55 yds/50 m

## TOOLS

- Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.
- 3" [7.5 cm] wide piece of cardboard for tassels.
- Tape measure.

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>Beg</b> = Beginning	<b>Rep</b> = Repeat
<b>Ch</b> = Chain(s)	<b>Rnd</b> = Round
<b>Dc</b> = Double crochet	<b>Sl st</b> = Slip stitch
<b>Rem</b> = Remaining	<b>Tog</b> = Together

## INSTRUCTIONS

### USING THIS GUIDE

## MEASUREMENTS

60" [152.5 cm] around x 10" [25.5 cm] wide.





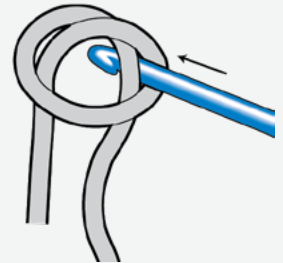
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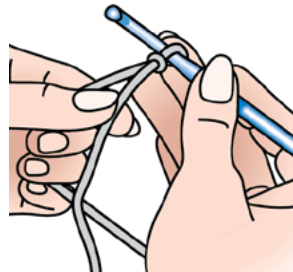
Holding 2 strands of A together (tog), make a slip knot and place it on the hook.



### Slip knot

*Make a loop with yarn and fold it on itself to make a pretzel shape.*

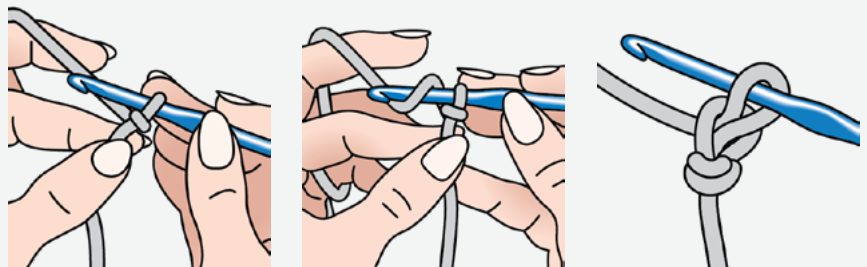
*Then draw through to make slip knot.*



Chain (ch) 120.

### Chain

*\*Yarn over hook (Yoh), pull through loop – 1 chain made.*

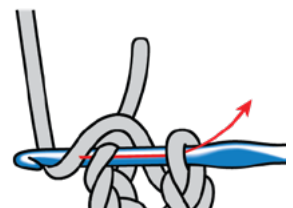


*Repeat (rep) from \* 119 times more – 120 chains made.*

Join with slip stitch (sl st) in first ch, taking care not to twist ch.

### Slip stitch

*Insert hook into first ch. Yoh and pull the yarn through both the work and the loop on the hook in one movement.*





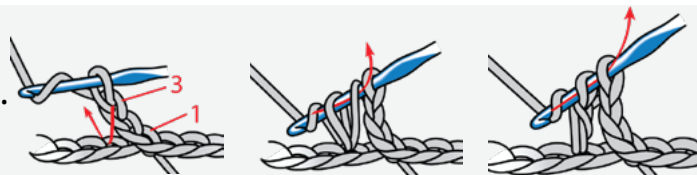
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**1st round (rnd):** Ch 3 (counts as double crochet - dc). 1 dc in each ch around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 120 dc.

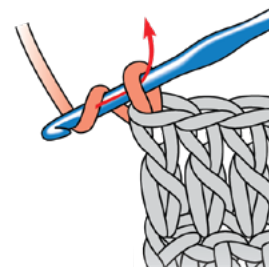


### Double crochet

*Yoh and insert hook into next ch and draw up a loop.  
Yoh and draw through first 2 loops on hook.  
Yoh and draw through remaining (rem) 2 loops on hook – 1 dc made.  
Rep last steps in each ch around - 120 dc made.*

**2nd rnd:** Ch 3. 1 dc in each dc around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Rep last rnd 10 times more. **Fasten off** at end of last rnd. *To fasten off the yarn, cut yarn leaving a long tail. Pull end through loop on hook and pull gently to tighten.*

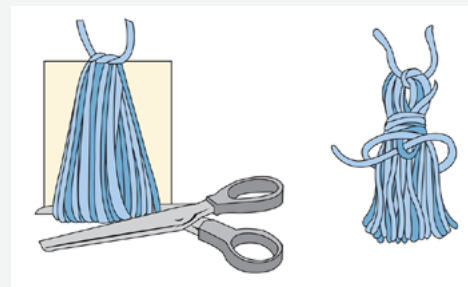


**Weave in** all yarn tails.

## FINISHING

### Tassels (Make 6)

Holding 1 strand each of A and B tog, wrap yarn around a 3" [7.5 cm] piece of cardboard 10 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across other end. Wrap yarn 3 times around tassel 1" [2.5 cm] from tied end. Fasten securely. Trim tassels to approx 2" [5 cm] length.



Attach Tassels to Snood, having 3 on either side edge, evenly spaced.
