Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circledR}$ (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Size U.S. I/9 ( 5.5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx $=$ Approximately $\quad$ Sc2tog $=$ Draw up a loop in each
Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Pat $=$ Pattern
Rem = Remaining
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS = Right side
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook.
Scbl = Single crochet in back
loop
$\mathbf{S I} \mathbf{s t}=$ Slip stitch
St(s) $=$ Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## SIZES

To fit head circumference
Child 2/4 years
$181 / 2$ " [ 47 cm ]
Child 6/10 years
19" [48 cm]
Adult Small
191/2" - 20½" [49.5-52cm]
Adult Large
21"-22" [53.5-56 cm]

## GAUGE

14 sts and 14 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Rib Pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written 2/4 (6/10, S, L). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: Balaclava is worked side to side.

## Yarnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

Ch 39 (49-57-59) loosely.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 38 (48-56-58) sc.
**2nd row: Ch 1. SI st in back loop of first sc. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc to last sc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked (sc and sl st). 36 (46-5456) sc rem

Rep last 2 rows 4 (4-5-5) times more, then 2nd row once. 28 (38-46-48) sc rem.
Next row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc to last sc. Working to end of row: ( 1 scbl in next sc. 1 sc in next sl st) 6 (6-7-7) times. Turn. 38 (48-5658) sc.**


Rep from ** to ** once more. Shape face opening: Upper Section: 1st row: Ch 1. SI st in back loop of first sc. 1 scbl in each of next 18 (23-26-28) sc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.
***2nd row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc to last sc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked (sc and sl st). 17 (22-2527) sc rem.

3rd row: Ch 1. Sl st in back loop of first sc. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep last 2 rows 2 (3-3-4) times more. 12 (15-18-18) sc rem.***

Next row: (RS). Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc to last sc. Working to end of row: ( 1 scbl in next sc. 1 sc in next sl st) 4 (5-5-6) times. Turn. 19 (24-2729) sc.

Next row: Ch 1. SI st in back loop of first sc. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep from ${ }^{* * *}$ to ${ }^{* * *}$ once more. Fasten off.

Lower Section: With WS facing, working across rem sts of Main Section, join yarn with sl st to back loop of next sc.
1st row: (WS). Ch 1. Working in back loops only, Sc2tog. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc to last 2 sts. Working in back loops only, Sc2tog.
3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row 7 (11-11-13) times more.
Next row: (RS). Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc to last sc. 2 scbl in last sc. Turn. Next row: Ch 1.2 scbl in first sc. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Joining row: (RS). Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc to last sc. 2 scbl in last sc of Lower Section. Working across Upper Section: 1 scbl in each sc to last sc. Working to end of row: ( 1 scbl in next sc. 1 sc in next sl st) 4 (5-4-5) times. Turn. 38 (48-5658) sc.


Rep from ** to ** as given above twice more. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew back seam. Weave yarn through last sl st of each row along top edge. Gather tightly and fasten securely.
