What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball 00009 Turquoise

Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle, 1 large button

TENSION/GAUGE: 15 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 16 rows = 10 cm [4"] in double crochet. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.

Button Spiderweb Scarf

Keep warm and look stylish with this crocheted scarf. The button lets you customize the look and keeps the scarf in place.

Scarf measures 16.5 cm [6½"] x 68.5 cm [27"].

SCARF

Ch 26.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Dc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across; turn – 25 dc.

Row 2 (Right Side): Ch 1, dc in first 3 dc, [ch 5, skip next 3 dc, dc in next 5 dc] twice, ch 5, skip next 3 dc, dc in last 3 dc; turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, dc in first 2 dc, [ch 3, dc in next ch-5 space, ch 3, skip next dc, dc in next 3 dc] twice, ch 3, dc in ch-5 space, ch 3, skip next dc, dc in last 2 dc; turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, dc in first dc, [ch 3, dc in next ch-3 space, dc in next dc, dc in next space, ch 3, skip next dc, dc in next dc] 3 times; turn.

Row 5: Ch 5 (counts as tr and ch 2), dc in next space, dc in next 3 dc, dc in space, [ch 5, dc in next space, dc in next 3 dc, dc in next space] twice, ch 2, tr in last dc; turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, dc in tr, ch 3, skip next dc, dc in next 3 dc, [ch 3, dc in next space, ch 3, skip next dc, dc in next 3 dc] twice, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of ch-5; turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, dc in first dc, dc in space, ch 3, skip next dc, dc in next dc, [ch 3, dc in next space, dc in next dc, dc in next space, ch 3, skip next dc, dc in next dc] twice, ch 3, dc in space, dc in last dc; turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, dc in first 2 dc, [dc in next space, ch 5, dc in next space, dc in next 3 dc] twice, dc in next space, ch 5, dc in next space, dc in last 2 dc; turn.

Repeat Rows 3-8 eleven times more or to desired length.

Next Row: Ch 1, dc in each st across and work 3 dc in each ch-5 space; turn – 25 dc.

Edging

Row 1 (Right Side): Ch 1, dc in each st across; turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, dc in first dc, * ch 3, skip next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across. Fasten off.

With right side facing, attach yarn on opposite side and repeat Rows 1 and 2 of edging. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Sew on button to desired location, using chspace as buttonhole.

Abbreviations

ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = triple or treble crochet; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
