## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Dreamy Stripes™:** 3 balls 9378 Ethereal

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
6 mm [US J-10].

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 4 pattern repeats = 3" (10 cm) (one pattern repeat consists of 2 double crochet and 1 chain-2 space); 8 rows = 5" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge



**RED HEART® Dreamy Stripes™,** E861S available in stripes 6.3 oz (180 g) 355 yd (325 m) balls

# Heartwarming Crochet Scarf

If you look closely you can see the little hearts in the stitch pattern. This makes it the perfect scarf to make when you want to include a subtle expression of love along with your hand-crocheted gift.

SHOP KIT

Scarf measures 16" x 75", including Border.

## Special Stitches

**dc3tog** = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 3 times, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

**picot:** Ch 4, sc in 4th ch from hook.

## SCARF First Half

Ch 55.

**Row 1 (right side):** Dc in 4th ch from hook and in next ch, \*ch 2, skip next 2 ch, dc in next ch; repeat from \* across to last 2 ch, dc in last 2 ch, turn—21 dc and 16 ch-2 spaces.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in next 2 dc, \*ch 2, dc in next dc, 4 dc in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from \* across to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn—36 dc.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, \*ch 2, dc in next 6 dc; repeat from \* across to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, \*ch 2, dc3tog, ch 3, dc3tog; repeat from \* across to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn—16 dc, 6 ch-2 spaces, and 5 ch-3 spaces.

**Row 5:** Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, \*ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in ch-3 space, ch 2, dc in next dc; repeat from \* across to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn—21 dc and 16 ch-2 spaces.

**Rows 6-61:** Repeat Rows 2-5. Fasten off.



## 2nd Half

**Row 1:** With right side of First Half facing and working in opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with slip st, ch 3, dc in next 2 ch, \*ch 2, dc in next ch, 4 dc in next ch, dc in next ch; repeat from \* across to last 3 ch, ch 2, dc in next 3 ch, turn—36 dc.

**Rows 2-4:** Repeat Rows 3-5 of First Half.

**Rows 5-60:** Repeat Rows 2-5 of First Half.

Fasten off.

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## Border

**Round 1:** With right side of either long edge facing and working in ends of rows, join yarn in first row, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), dc in same row (corner made), \*(ch 2, dc) in each row across to last row, (dc, ch 2, dc) in last row (corner made), working across short edge, (ch 2, dc) in each ch-2 space across; working in other long edge, repeat from \* around; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch—4 corner ch-2 spaces.

**Round 2:** Slip st in first corner ch-2 space, ch 1, \*3 sc in same space, (2 sc, picot) in each ch-2 space around to next corner ch-2 space; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Lightly block to finished measurements.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet;  
**sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es);  
( ) = work directions in parentheses into same st; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified;  
\* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
