What you will need:

RED HEART® Croquette™: 2 balls 9582 Calming

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 3.75mm [US F-5]

Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 19 sts (one pattern repeat) = about $3\frac{1}{2}$ " [9 cm]; 15 rows = about 7" [18 cm] in pattern. GAUGE IS NOT CRITICAL FOR THIS PROJECT. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

RED HEART® Croquette™, Art E887 available in 1.58 oz (45 g), 239 yd (219 m)

Dainty Feather & Fan Scarf

Enjoy wearing this beautiful accessory any season of the year! These cute little balls give you a weight that is similar to crochet thread but is softer and has a bit of sparkle.

Scarf measures about 7" [18 cm] wide and 70" [178 cm] long.

Notes

- 1. Scarf is worked back and forth in rows.
- 2. Edging is worked along each long side edge of completed scarf.

SCARF

Ch 39.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across-38 sc.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, 4 tr in first st, tr in next st, [skip next st, tr in next st] 8 times, 5 tr in each of next 2 sts, tr in next st, [skip next st, tr in next st] 8 times, 5 tr in last st-38 tr (2 pattern repeats).

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across-38 sc.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 70" [178 cm]. Do not fasten off.

Side Edging

Do not turn, working along side edge, work 1 sc in end of each sc row and 4 sc in end of each tr row all the way along side edge. Fasten off.

Draw up a loop of yarn in corner at beginning of other side edge and work 1 sc in end of each sc row and 4 sc in end of each tr row all the way along side edge. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block scarf to size.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble (triple) crochet; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
