What you will need:

RED HEART® Hygge™: 2 balls 8340 Sterling A and 1 ball each 8631 Aloe B and 8568 Slate Blue C

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 9mm [US M-13].

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 10 hdc = 4'' (10 cm); 7 rows = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Color-Block Crochet Scarf

A combination of patterns and colors adds interest to a scarf that is a luxury to wear. The softness of the lovely furry texture is smooth next to your skin and wonderful to crochet!

Scarf measures 8" x 70" (15 x 178 cm).

Special Stitches

Shell: (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in indicated space.

SCARF

With A, ch 20.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across, turn-19 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, working in front loops only, hdc in each hdc across, turn.

Rows 4-13: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 five times; change to **B** at end of Row 13.

Row 14: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch 1 here and throughout), skip next hdc, dc in next hdc, *ch 1, skip next hdc, dc in next hdc; repeat from * across, turn-10 dc and 9 ch-1 spaces.

Row 15: Ch 4, skip first ch-1 space, dc in next dc, *[dc in next ch-1 space, dc in next dc] 3 times, ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next dc; repeat from * across, working last dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch. turn-16 dc and 3 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 16 and 17: Ch 4, skip first ch-1 space. *dc in next 7 dc. ch 1. skip next ch-1 space; repeat from * across, dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch, turn.

Row 18: Ch 4, skip first ch-1 space, dc in next dc, *[ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc1 3 times, ch 1, skip next ch-1 space. dc in next dc; repeat from * across, working last dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch. turn-10 dc and 9 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 19-22: Repeat Rows 15-18; change to A at end of Row 22.

Row 23: Ch 2, hdc in each dc and ch-1 space across, turn-19 hdc.

Rows 24-35: Repeat Rows 2-13; change to C1 at end of Row 34.



Row 36: Repeat Row 14.

Row 37: Ch 4, skip first ch-1 space, shell in next ch-1 space, *skip next ch-1 space, shell in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across, ch 1, skip last ch-1 space, dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch, turn-4 shells, 2 dc, and 2 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 38-42: Ch 4, shell in ch-1 space of each shell, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch, turn.

SHOP KIT



Row 43: Ch 4, (dc in first dc, ch 1, dc in 3rd dc) of first shell, (ch 1, dc in first dc, ch 1, dc in 3rd dc) of each remaining shell, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch; change to **A**, turn—10 dc and 9 ch-1 spaces.

Row 44: Repeat Row 23.

Rows 45-87: Repeat Rows 2-44.

Rows 88-99: Rows 2-13.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = A, B, C, etc.; ch = ch(s); dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses in same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
