What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver: 1 skein each 312 Black **A**, 356 Amethyst **B**, 672 Spring Green **C** and 254 Pumpkin **D**

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 20 sts = 6" [15 cm]; 10 rows = 6" [15 cm] in pattern st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Jittery Stripes Hat & Scarf

This interesting pattern is so much fun to crochet you won't want to put it down! We've chosen four frightening colors that are just right for a sophisticated Halloween party scene!

Scarf measures 6" (15 cm) x 62" (157.5 cm)

Beanie measures 20" (50.8 cm) in circumference for small and 22" (55.9 cm) in circumference for large.

Note

When changing colors, work last step of last st of previous color with new color.

SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

Adjustable loop ring: Holding the thread a few inches [cms] from the end, wrap around your finger. Do not remove wrap from finger, insert hook into the wrap and draw up a loop of working thread. Chain one to secure the loop and remove ring from finger. Work stitches of first round in the ring. Pull gently, but firmly, on tail to tighten ring

Fdc (Foundation double crochet): Ch 3 (counts as first st), yarn over, insert hook in 3rd ch from hook and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (ch made); [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice (dc made), *yarn over, insert hook into ch stitch and draw up a loop; yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (ch made), [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice (dc made); repeat from * for as many Fdc as called for in pattern.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

V-st: (Dc, ch 1, dc) all in same st or space.

Spike V-st: (Dc, ch 1, dc) in base of V-st of previous row, pulling up sts to same height as working row/round.

PATTERN STITCHES

Stripe Sequence

Working in pattern st, work 2 rows with **A**, 2 rows with **B**, 2 rows with **C** and 2 rows with **D**. Repeat these 8 rows for Stripe Sequence.

SCARF

Row 1: With **A**, Fdc 20 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in same st, [skip next st, V-st in next st, skip next st, dc in next 2 sts] 3 times, skip next st, V-st in next st, skip next st, 2 dc in last st.

Row 3: Change to **B**, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, dc in same st, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st, dc in next 2 dc, Spike V-st in base of next V-st, dc in next 2 dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st, dc in next 2 dc, Spike V-st in base of next V-st, 2 dc in last st.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in same st, [V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st or Spike V-st, dc in next 2 dc] 3 times, V-st in ch-1 space of last V-st or Spike V-st, 2 dc in last st.

Row 5: Change to **C**, 3, turn, dc in same st, Spike V-st in base of next V-st, dc in next 2 dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st, dc in next 2 dc, Spike V-st in base of next V-st, dc in next 2 dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st, 2 dc in last st.

Row 6: Repeat Row 4.

Keeping in Stripe Sequence, repeat Rows 3-6 until Scarf measures 62" [157 cm] from beginning, end with second row of color in Stripe Sequence. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

BEANIE

With **A**, make an adjustable loop ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 11 dc in ring, slip st in top of beginning ch-3 to join – 12 dc. Tighten beginning loop.

Round 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch-1 here and throughout), dc in same st for first V-st, V-st in each st around, slip st to 3rd ch of beginning ch-4 – 12 V-sts.

Continued...

SHOP KIT

Round 3: Slip st to first ch-1 space, change to **B**, ch 4, dc in same st, [dc in second dc of V-st of previous row, Spike V-st in base of next V-st, dc in second dc of V-st of previous row, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st] 5 times, dc in second dc of V-st of previous row, Spike V-st in base of next V-st, dc in second dc of V-st of previous row, slip st to 3rd ch of beginning ch-4 – 6 V-sts, 6 Spike V-sts and 12 dc.

For Small Only

Round 4: Slip st to first ch-1 space, ch 4, dc in same st, [dc in next dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st, dc in second dc of V-st of previous row, dc in next dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st] 5 times, dc in next dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st, dc in second dc of V-st of previous row, dc in next dc, slip st to 3rd ch of beginning ch-4 – 12 V-sts and 18 dc.

For Large Only

Round 4: Slip st to first ch-1 space, ch 4, dc in same st, [dc in second dc of V-st of previous row, dc in next dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st] 11 times, dc in second dc of V-st of previous row, dc in next dc, slip st to 3rd ch of beginning ch-4 – 12 V-sts and 24 dc.

For Both Sizes

Round 5: Slip st to first ch-1 space, change to **C**, ch 4, dc in same st, [dc in next 1 (2) dc, Spike V-st in base of next V-st, dc in next 2 dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st] 5 times, dc in next 1 (2) dc, Spike V-st in base of next V-st, dc in next 2 dc, slip st to 3rd ch of beginning ch-4 – 6 V-sts, 6 Spike V-sts and 18 (24) dc.

Round 6: Slip st to first ch-1 space, ch 4, dc in same st, [dc in next 1 (2) dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next Spike V-st, dc in next 2 dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st] 5 times, dc in next 1 (2) dc, V-st in ch-1 space of next Spike V-st, dc in next 2 dc, slip st to 3rd ch of beginning ch-4 – 12 V-sts and 18 (24) dc.

Round 7: Change to **D** and repeat Round 5.

Round 8: Repeat Round 6.

Rounds 9-13: Keeping in Stripe Sequence, repeat Rounds 5-6 twice more, then Round 5 once.

Rounds 14-15: Using last color, sc in each dc and ch-1 space around, slip st to first st to join. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
