# What you will need:

RED HEART® Reflective™: 2 balls 8251 Neon Orange E, and 1 ball each 8242 Neon Yellow A, 8671 Neon Green B, 8704 Neon Pink C, 8012 Black D, and 8429 Grey F

Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks: 6mm [US J-10] and 8mm [US L-11]

Yarn needle, rustproof straight pins

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4" (10 cm); 11 rows = 4" (10 cm) in pattern with larger hook. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Shine On Scarf

No need to decide on just one shade of yarn, use a half dozen shades for a more spirited scarf look. You'll love the way this yarn reflects the flash of a camera. Great for taking photos where you are sure to shine!

**SHOP KIT** 

Scarf measures 8" x 70" (20.5 x 178 cm), not including fringe

#### **Special Stitches**

**Fsc:** Foundation single crochet (This technique creates a foundation chain and a row of single crochet stitches in one) –

Step 1: Place a slip knot on hook, ch 2, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook and draw up a loop; yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (the "chain"); yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (the "single crochet").

Step 2: Insert hook into the "chain" of the previous stitch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (the "chain"), yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (the "single crochet"). Repeat for the length of foundation.

#### **Notes**

- 1. Scarf has 2 different stitch patterns worked alternately with each change of color.
- 2. Due to different stitch patterns, you may need to change hooks to maintain width throughout.
- Long loops of chains are added to each end as fringes.
- 4. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

### **SCARF**

**Row 1 (right side):** With larger hook and **A**, Fsc 23, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, \*ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* to last sc, sc in last sc, turn—13 sc and 10 ch-1 spaces.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* to last 2 sc, ch 1, skip next sc, sc in last sc, turn—12 sc and 11 ch-1 spaces.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next ch-1 space, \*ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* to last sc, sc in last sc, turn—13 sc and 10 ch-1 spaces.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* to last 2 sc, ch 1, skip next sc, sc in last sc, turn—12 sc and 11 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 6–19: Repeat Rows 4 and 5 seven times. Change to **B** in last st of Row 19. Row 20: Ch 1, sc in first sc, dc in next ch-1 space, \*sc in next sc, dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, turn—12 sc and 11 dc.

Row 21: Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* across, turn—12 sc and 11 ch-1 spaces.

**Rows 22–35:** Repeat Rows 20 and 21 seven times. Change to **C** in last st of Row 35.

**Rows 36–55:** Repeat Rows 4 and 5 ten times. Change to **D** in last st of Row 55.

**Rows 56–69:** Repeat Rows 20 and 21 seven times. Change to **E** in last st of Row 69.

Rows 70–83: Repeat Rows 4 and 5 seven times. Change to **F** in last st of Row 83.

Rows 84–103: Repeat Rows 20 and 21 ten times. Change to **E** in last st of Row 103.

Rows 104–117: Repeat Rows 4 and 5 seven times. Change to **D** in last st of Row 117.

Rows 118–131: Repeat Rows 20 and 21 seven times. Change to **C** in last st of Row 131.

**Rows 132–151:** Repeat Rows 4 and 5 ten times. Change to **B** in last st of Row 151.

Rows 152–167: Repeat Rows 20 and 21 eight times. Change to **A** in last st of Row 167.

Rows 168–185: Repeat Rows 4 and 5 nine times.

Row 186: Ch 1, sc in each sc and ch-1 space across. Fasten off.

# Fringe

With right side of one end facing and smaller hook, join **E** with slip st to 2nd sc, ch 45, slip st in first sc, \*ch 45, skip next unworked sc, slip st in next sc, ch 45, slip st in skipped sc; repeat from \* across. Fasten off. Repeat for other end.

#### **FINISHING**

Wet block fringe by stretching each loop to 7"/18cm length, pin in place, and spray with water.
Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
