

CROCHET SKILL LEVEL INTERMEDIATE

What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 2 balls 4420 Guacamole

Susan Bates Crochet Hook®: 5 mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 6 rows in pattern = 3.75" [9.5 cm]. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Loops for Fringe Scarf

The loopy fringe and pretty stitch pattern takes this scarf from out of the ordinary to interesting and extraordinary! Crochet it in your favorite color and enjoy! Or gift it to a favorite friend!

Scarf measures 6" (15 cm) x 60" (152.5 cm)

#### Special Technique

Join with sc: Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

## **SCARF**

Ch 26.

Row 1 (Right side): 2 dc in 6th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as ch-2, dc), ch 5, 2 dc in next ch, \*skip 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch, skip 2 ch, 2 dc in next ch, ch 5, 2 dc in next ch; repeat from \* once; skip 2 ch, dc in last ch, turn - 18 dc, 3 ch-5 loops.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 2 dc, 2 sc in ch-5 loop, \*dc in next 6 dc, 2 sc in ch-5 loop; repeat from \* once; dc in next 2 dc and top of ch-3, turn – 24 sts.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), \*skip 2 dc, 2 dc in next sc, ch 5, 2 dc in next sc, skip 2 dc\*\*, dc in next 2 dc; repeat from \* across, ending last repeat at \*\*; dc in top of ch-3, turn – 18 dc, 3 ch-5 loops.

Rows 4-82: Repeat Rows 2-3 for pattern, ending with Row 2. Fasten off.

### EDGING (2)

Work Edging across top and bottom ends of Scarf.

**Row 1:** With wrong side facing, join with sc, sc in each st across, turn – 24 sc. Row 2: (Ch 7, skip 7 sc, sc in next sc) 3 times,

turn.

Row 3: Slip stitch in first loop, (ch 3, 3 dc, ch 2, 4 dc) in same loop, (4 dc, ch 2, 4 dc) in each of next 2 loops, turn.

Row 4: \*Ch 3, sc in next ch-2 space, (ch 15, sc, ch 17, sc, ch 15, sc) in same space, ch 3\*\*, sc in space between next 2 4-dc groups; repeat from \* across, ending last repeat at \*\*; slip stitch in top of ch-3, fasten off. Weave in Ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet: **st(s)** = stitch(es): \* **or** \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
