# What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Changes®: 2 balls 9403 Granite

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [K-10.5]

Yarn needle, one 2" (5mm) button

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical to this project.

# Appliqués à la Freeform Scarf

Freeform crocheters usually use many different yarns to create their interesting multi-textured projects. But with this yarn the texture changes as you work, so you only need one yarn to create this scarf!

Scarf measures 10" x 38" (25 cm x 96.5 cm)

## **SCARF**

Beginning at bottom, ch 23.

**Row 1:** Sc in 8th ch from hook, [ch 5, skip next 4 ch, sc in next ch] 3 times, turn—4 loops.

Rows 2-12: Ch 7, sc in first loop, ch 5, \*sc in next loop, ch 5; repeat from \* across to last loop, sc in the 3rd ch of beginning ch-7, turn.

Row 13: Ch 7, sc in first loop, ch 5, \*sc in next loop, ch 5; repeat from \* across to last loop, sc in last loop, ch 5, tr in the 3rd ch of the beginning ch-7 (increase made), turn—5 loops.

Rows 14-16: Repeat Row 2.

Row 17: Repeat Row 13—6 loops.

Rows 18-21: Repeat Row 2.

Row 22: Repeat Row 13—7 loops.

Rows 23-26: Repeat Row 2.

Row 27: Ch 1, 4 sc in first loop, 5 sc in each of next 5 loops 5 times, 4 sc in last loop, turn—33 sc.

Rows 28-107: Ch 1, sc in back loop of each sc across. turn.

**Buttonhole Row:** Ch 1, sc in first 16 sc, ch 6, skip next 6 sc, sc in remaining11 sc, turn—27 sc and ch-6 loop.

**Next Row:** Ch 1, sc in first 11 sc, sc in each ch of the loop, sc on remaining 16 sc—33 sc. Fasten off.

# Paisley (make 2)

Ch 13.

Round 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 2 ch, hdc in next 4 ch, dc in next 4 ch, 5 dc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, dc in next 4 ch, hdc in next 4 ch, sc in next 3 ch, do not join and do not turn—27 sts.

Row 2 (right side): Working in back loops only, sc in first 10 sts, 2 sc each of next 8 sts, leave remaining sts unworked—26 sts. Fasten off. Row 3 (right side): Join yarn with slip st to back loop of first sc, ch 1, working back loops

only, sc in first 4 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in each of next 13 sts, hdc next st, sc in next st, slip st in last st—39 sts. Fasten off.

### Flower (make 2)

Ch 4, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring. **Round 1:** Ch 1, work 10 sc in ring, join with slip st in first sc—10 sc.

**Round 2:** [Ch 2, work 3 tr in next st, ch 2, slip st in next st (petal made)] 5 times, join with slip st in first ch of beginning ch-2—5 petals. Fasten off.

### Fan (make 3)

Ch 7, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring. Row 1: Ch 1, work 6 sc in ring, do not join, turn—6 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in first sc, 2 dc in each sc across, turn—12 dc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each dc across, turn—12 sc. Row 4: Ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch 2), skip first sc, dc in next sc, \*ch 2, skip next sc, dc in next sc; repeat from \* across, turn—6 ch-2 spaces.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, (sc, hdc, ch 3, slip st in top of last hdc made, hdc, sc) in each ch-space—6 repeats. Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

Using photograph as a guide, sew paisleys, flowers, and fans to bottom mesh of scarf. Fold at neck to form collar and sew button to inner edge of Row 28.

Blocking is not recommended for this garment.

the \* as indicated.
