



## Rows of Ruffles Scarf

*Ruffles are trendy and also very girly. This ruffled scarf with a little sparkle dresses up any outfit. It's so easy to make, you'll want to make several.*

Designed by Michele Wilcox.

**Scarf measures 5" wide x 52½" long.**  
**RED HEART® "Shimmer™":** 2 balls 1625 Lime.

**Crochet Hook:** 4mm [USG-6].  
Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 6 sts = 1½"; 2 rows = 1" in dc. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

### SCARF

#### Side (Make 2)

**Row 1:** Ch 21; sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across; turn – 20 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 4, working in back loops only, 2 tr in first sc, 3 tr in each sc across; turn – 60 tr.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, skip first tr, dc in each tr across and in top of ch-4; slip st down side edge of dc and tr rows, then slip st in first front loop unworked on sc row; turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, skip first front loop, dc in each front loop across; turn – 20 dc.

**Rows 5 and 6:** Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in each dc across and in top of ch-3; turn.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, sc in each dc across and in top of ch-3; turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 4, working in back loops only, tr in first sc, 2 tr in each sc across; turn – 40 tr.

**Rows 9-77:** Repeat Rows 3-8, then repeat Rows 3 and 4 again. You will have 13 ruffles. Fasten off. Seam 2 sides together at center back neck.

### Edging

With right side facing, join yarn with a slip st in first dc of first Row 3, \* skip next dc, 5 dc in next dc \*\*, skip next dc, slip st in next dc; repeat from \* to last 3 dc, end at \*\*: slip st in last dc. Fasten off. Weave in ends. Repeat Edging on opposite end.
