



Infinity Scarf

Named the Infinity scarf because it is a complete circle, you'll love the seemingly endless ways you can wear it. This crocheted scarf is perfect as a daytime accessory, practical for keeping your neck warm or romantic when worn over bare shoulders.

Designed by Ann Regis.

Scarf measures 8½" wide (including ruffle) x 74" around.

RED HEART® "Stardust™": 4 balls 1805 Blue.

Crochet Hooks: 4mm [US G-6] and 10.5mm [US K-10½].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 22 sts = 4"; 10 rows = 4" in double crochet using smaller hook. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

SCARF

Shell Section

With smaller hook, ch 42.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc) and in each remaining ch across, turn—40 dc.

Row 2: Ch 1, hdc in first dc, [skip next 4 dc, 9 tr in next dc, skip next 4 dc, hdc in next dc] 3 times, skip next 4 dc, 9 tr in next dc, skip next 3 dc, hdc in top of turning ch, turn—Four 9-tr groups.

Row 3: Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 1), tr in first hdc, [ch 5, skip next 9-tr group, (tr, ch 3, tr) in next hdc] 3 times, ch 5, skip last 9-tr group, (tr, ch 1, tr) in last hdc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 4 (counts as tr), 4 tr in first ch-1 space, [working over next ch-5 space, hdc in 5th tr of next skipped 9-tr group 2 rows below, 9 tr in next ch-3 space] 3 times, working over next ch-5 space, hdc in 5th tr of next 9-tr group 2 rows below, 5 tr in turning ch-space, turn—Three 9-tr groups and two 5-tr groups.

Row 5: Ch 1, hdc in first tr, ch 2, skip next 4 tr, (tr, ch 3, tr) in next hdc, [ch 5, skip next 9-tr group, (tr, ch 3, tr) in next hdc] 3 times, ch 2, skip next 4 tr, hdc in top of turning ch, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, hdc in first st, skip next ch-2 space, 9 tr in next ch-3 space, [working over next ch-5 space, hdc in 5th tr of next skipped 9-tr group 2 rows below, 9 tr in next ch-3 space] 3 times, skip last ch-2 space, hdc in last hdc, turn—Four 9-tr groups.

Rows 7–18: Repeat Rows 3–6 three times.

Row 19: Repeat Row 3. Do not fasten off.

Row 20: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in first ch-1 space, *3 dc in next ch-5 space, working over same ch-5 space, dc in 5th tr of next 9-tr group 2 rows below, 3 dc in same ch-5 space, 3 dc in next ch-3 space, 3 dc in next ch-5 space, working over same ch-5 space, dc in 5th tr of next 9-tr group 2 rows below, 3 dc in same ch-5 space, 2 dc in next ch-space; repeat from * once, turn—40 dc.

Mesh Section

Row 21: Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in next dc, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across, turn—21 dc and 19 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 22–25: Ch 3, dc in first ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across to last 2 dc, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in top of turning ch, turn.

Row 26: Ch 3, 2 dc in each ch-1 space across, dc in space between last dc and turning ch, turn—40 dc.

Rows 27 and 28: Repeat Rows 21 and 22.



Row 29: Repeat Row 26.

Row 30: Repeat Row 21.

Rows 31–34: Repeat Rows 22–25.

Row 35: Repeat Row 26.

Rows 36–103: Repeat Rows 2–35 twice.

Rows 104–136: Repeat Rows 2–34.

Sew or slip st last row to first row to form a ring.

Ruffle

Round 1: With Right Side facing and larger hook, join yarn with slip st anywhere in one side edge, ch 1, sc evenly spaced all the way around side edge; join with slip st in first sc. **Note:** Space the sc sts to ensure that edge of fabric doesn't bunch or pucker.

Round 2: Ch 4, dc in same sc as join, ch 1, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next sc, ch 1; repeat from * around; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4. Fasten off.

Repeat around other side edge.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble crochet; **()** = work directions in parentheses into indicated stitch; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
