



## Super Easy Scarf

*Here's a great first scarf pattern if you are learning to crochet or for an experienced crocheter to make when it's needed in a hurry.*

Designed by Kim Kotary.

Scarf measures 5" x 60".

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:** 1 skein each 312 Black **A** and 254 Pumpkin **B**.

**Crochet Hook:** 5.5mm [US I-9].  
Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 18 sts = 5" in stitch pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

**NOTE:** Carry color not in use along side of work.

### SCARF

With **A**, ch 20.

**Row 1:** Sc in 3rd ch from hook, [ch 1, skip 1, sc in next st] across – 18 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as ch-space here and throughout), turn, [sc in next ch-space, ch 1] across, sc in last ch-space – 18 sts.

**Row 3:** Change to **B**, ch 2, turn, [sc in next ch-space, ch 1] across, sc in last ch-space.

Repeat Rows 2-3, alternating colors every 2 rows until piece measures 60" from beginning, end with 2 rows of **A**. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.



**RED HEART® Super Saver®**, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **A, B** = Color A, B; **ch** = chain; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
