What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love
Chunky™:** 3 skeins 1803 Blue
Hawaii

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5.5 mm [US I-9]

4" [10 cm] x 7" [18 cm] piece
of cardboard, yarn needle

GAUGE: 9 sts = 4" [10 cm];
6 rows = 4" [10 cm] in rib st.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use
any size hook to obtain the
gauge.

Double Crochet Rib Scarf

This scarf is perfect for chilly days,
and the tassels add a cute bit of flair!
Made in With Love Chunky, it works up
quick, making it a great gift option.

**Scarf measures 7½" [19 cm] x 74" [188
cm] long, excluding fringe.**

NOTE

Scarf is worked lengthwise in a rib stitch.
Stitches are worked in horizontal bar
below top 2 loops of stitch on previous
row. Top 2 loops will create rib stitch
along opposite side.

SCARF

Ch 166.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped
3 ch count as first dc), dc in each ch
across – 164 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first st here and
throughout), turn, working in horizontal
bar of each st across, dc in horizontal
bar of each dc across.

Rows 3-12: Repeat Row 2.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Tassel Fringe (make 8)

Cut 16 lengths of yarn, each 10" [26 cm]
long, and set aside for Ties.

Wrap yarn around 7" [18 cm] cardboard
14 times. Slip one Tie around all strands
at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly
and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn
loops at lower edge of cardboard. Wrap
second Tie tightly around loops 1" [2.5
cm] below top knot to form Tassel neck.
Knot securely; thread ends onto needle
and weave ends to center of Tassel. Trim
Tassel ends evenly.

Repeat to make 8 Tassels.

Tie four Tassels evenly spaced along
each short end of Scarf.

ch = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** =
double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)**
= stitch(es).



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
