CRED HEART NOUVEAU TIPPET SCARF Designed by QuayIn Stark | CROCHET



MATERIALS

Red Heart® Hygge Fur™ (7 oz/200 g; 260 yds/238 m) Sangria (0913) **2 balls**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.



🖗 CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS Approx = Approximately Ch = Chain(s) Hdc = Half double crochet

St(s) = Stitch(es)

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 7" [18 cm] wide x 50" [127 cm] long.

GAUGE

12 hdc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Wear this modern tippet around your shoulders as is, or classically folded over and pinned with a chic brooch!
- Tippet is worked as a long tube for a double layer thickness. It is worked in a continuous round with right sides facing out.

TIPPET

Ch 23.

Round 1: Hdc in second ch from hook and in next 21 ch; rotate work, hdc in bottom of the same 22 ch – 44 hdc. **Round 2:** Hdc in first hdc of previous round (working in a continuous round without joining) and in each hdc around – 44 hdc.

Repeat Round 2 until piece measures 50" (127 cm) or desired length. Slip st in last st of final round.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Lay tippet flat. With a 10"-(25.5 cm) length of yarn and yarn needle, whipstitch raw end together to close tube. Weave in all ends.
