Red Heart® Heat Wave™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 198 yds/181 m)

Main Color (MC) Passport (0410) 4 balls

Contrast A Sandy Shores (0110) 1 ball

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.









ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

 $\mathbf{Dc} = \text{Double crochet}$

Fch = Foundation chain (underside of foundation double

crochet row).

Fdc = (Foundation double crochet) - Ch 3 (counts as first st). Yoh, Insert hook in 3rd ch from hook and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through one loop on hook (ch made). (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice (1 dc made). *Yoh. Insert hook into ch stitch and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through one loop on hook (ch made). (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice (1 dc made). Rep from * for as many fdc as called for in pattern.

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remain(s)(ing)

Rep = Repeat(s)

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

Trfp = (Yoh) twice and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook



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MEASUREMENTS

Approx 10" x 74" [25.5 x 188 cm], excluding fringe.

GAUGE

11 sts and 10 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in main st pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Ch 3 at beg of rows counts as dc throughout.
- Always skip sc above any dc that a trfp is worked around.
- To join new color, work to last loops on hook of first color. Yoh with new color, draw through loops and proceed with new color.

1st row: (RS). With MC, fdc 27. Turn. 27 sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3. *1 trfp around dc below next sc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st across. Turn.

5th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in next sc. *1 trfp around dc below next sc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * until 1 st rem. 1 dc in last st. Turn.

Rep 2nd to 5th rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 73" [185.5 cm], ending on a 5th row. **Do not** turn.

Edging

1st rnd: Ch 1. *Work in sc evenly along side of scarf to corner. Ch 2. 1 sc in first st of fch. **Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from ** to corner. Ch 2. Rep from * once more. Ch 2. Join to first st of edging with sl st. Fasten off.

Pockets (make 2)

1st row: (RS). With MC, fdc 23. Join A. Turn. 23 sts.

2nd row: With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each st across. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3. *1 trfp around dc below next sc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end. Join MC. Turn.

4th row: With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each st across. Turn.

5th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in next sc. *1 trfp around dc below next sc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * until 1 st rem. 1 dc in last st. Join A. Turn.

Rep 2nd to 5th rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 8.5" [21.5 cm]. **Do not** turn.

Pocket Edging

1st rnd: With MC, ch 1. Work 1 rnd of sc evenly around square, working a ch-2 at each corner. Join to first st of edging with sl st. Fasten off.

Assembly and Finishing:

Sew pockets to scarf using MC, at desired height or approximately 2" [5 cm] from the ends.

Cut 90 pieces of MC, and 60 pieces of A, each measuring 12" [30.5 cm] long. Taking 3 strands of MC and 2 strands of A tog, fold in half and knot into fringe in each ch-1 and ch-2 sp at both ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
