What you will need:

RED HEART® It's a Wrap™: 1 ball 9243 Western

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 2.75mm [US C-2]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 rows in pattern stitch = 4" (10 cm). 20 dc on Row 3 of pattern = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use** any size needles/hook to obtain the gauge given.

Wonderful Shells Wrap

Perfect to wear as a shawl or as a scarf, this versatile crocheted beauty will soon become your go-to accessory. The lightweight softness makes it a wardrobe essential for any season and climate.

Wrap measures 16" (40.5 cm) long x 69" (175 cm) wide.

WRAP

Chain 442.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 8th ch from hook (counts as first ch-4 loop), *(ch 4, skip 3 chains, sc in next ch) 3 times**, ch 8, skip 6 chains, sc in next ch; repeat from * 22 times, ending last repeat at **; ch 4, skip 3 chains, dc in last ch; turn-71 ch-4 loops and 22 ch-8 loops.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc now and throughout), 5 dc in first ch-4 loop, *sc in next ch-4 loop, (ch 4, sc in next ch-4 loop) twice**, 10 dc in next ch-8 loop; repeat from * 22 times, ending last repeat at **; 6 dc in last ch-4 loop; turn. Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next 5 dc, *sc in next ch-4 loop, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 loop**, dc in next 10 dc; repeat from * 22 times, ending last repeat at **; dc in last 6 dc; turn.

Row 4: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch-1), (dc, ch 1) in next 4 dc, dc in next dc, *skip next ch-4 loop, (dc, ch 1) in next 9 dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * 21 times, skip last ch-4 loop, (dc, ch 1) in next 5 dc, dc in last dc: turn.

Row 5: (Ch 4, skip ch-1 loop, sc in next ch-1 loop) twice, *ch 8, skip next 2 ch-1 loops, sc in next ch-1 loop, (ch 4, skip next ch-1 loop, sc in next ch-1 loop) 3 times; repeat from * 21 times, ch 8, skip next 2 ch-1 loops, sc in next ch-1 loop, ch 4, skip next ch-1 loop, sc in next ch-1 loop, ch 4, sc in 3rd ch of ch-4; turn-70 ch-4 loops and 23 ch-8 loops.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first ch-4 loop, ch 4, sc in same loop, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 loop, *10 dc in next ch-8 loop, sc in next ch-4 loop, (ch 4, sc in next ch-4 loop) twice; repeat from * 21 times, 10 dc in next ch-8 loop, sc in next ch-4 loop, ch 4. sc in last ch-4 loop, ch 4. sc in same loop: turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first ch-4 loop, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 loop, *dc in next 10 dc, sc in next ch-4 loop, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 loop; repeat from * 21 times, dc in next 10 dc, sc in next ch-4 loop, ch 4, sc in last ch-4 loop: turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first ch-4 loop, *(dc. ch 1) in next 9 dc, dc in next dc**, skip next ch-4 loop; repeat from * 22 times, ending last repeat at **; sc in last ch-4 loop: turn.

Row 9: Ch 8, skip first ch-1 loop, sc in next ch-1 loop, *(ch 4, skip next ch-1 loop, sc in next ch-1 loop) 3 times, ch 8**, skip next 2 ch-1 loops, sc in next ch-1 loop; repeat from * 22 times, ending last repeat at **; sc in last sc; turn-24 ch-8 loops and 69 ch-4 loops.

Row 10: Ch 3, 5 dc in first ch-8 loop, *sc in next ch-4 loop, (ch 4, sc in next ch-4 loop) twice**, 10 dc in next ch-8 loop; repeat from * 22 times, ending last repeat at **; 6 dc in last ch-8 loop; turn.

Rows 11-17: Repeat Rows 3-9. **Rows 18-57:** Repeat Rows 10-17.

Rows 58-59: Repeat Rows 10-11. At end of Row 59, fasten off and weave in ends.
