What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\bullet}$ Fashion Soft ${ }^{\mathrm{m}}$ : 1 ball each 4650 Artichoke A, 4604 Navy B, and 9440 Grey Heather C

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle, 3 stitch markers
GAUGE: 14 sts and 6 rows dc $=$ $4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given. 381 yd ( 348 m ) balls

## Light \& Lacy Shawl

This lightweight yarn is perfect for a wrap that you'll wear all year! Choose three shades of this smooth yarn and crochet a versatile accessory for day or evening.

Shawl measures 48 " ( 122 cm ) wide $\times 24$ " ( 61 cm ) tall.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

Picot: Ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook.

## PATTERN NOTES

1. To mimic Color Sequence in example: Row 1 - 30: Color A (Green)
Row 31 - 34: Color B (Navy)
Row 35-36: Color C (Grey Heather)
2. Use stitch markers to repeat pattern with greater ease: one for first dc of row, one for last dc of row, one for ch 3 space. Move st markers as you go.

## SHAWL

With A, form an adjustable ring
Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc, here and
throughout), (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc ) in ring; turn
$-6 \mathrm{dc} ; 1 \mathrm{ch}-3$ space. Pull tail to close center ring
Row 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in first st, ch 5, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-3 space, ch 5, skip next 2 dc, 3 dc in top of beginning ch-3-10 dc; $1 \mathrm{ch}-3$ space; 2 ch-5 spaces.
Row 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in first st, ch 5, (sc, ch 5) in each ch-5 space across to next ch-3 space, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-3 space, ch 5 , ( sc, ch 5) in each ch-5 space across to last 3 dc , skip next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in top of beginning ch-3 - 10 dc; 1 ch-3 space; 4 ch-5 spaces.

## Rows 4-30: Repeat Row 3 - $10 \mathrm{dc} ; 1$ ch-3

 space; 58 ch-5 spaces at end of last row. Fasten off $\mathbf{A}$, join $\mathbf{B}$.Rows 31-34: With B, repeat Row 3 - 10 dc ; $1 \mathrm{ch}-3$ space; $66 \mathrm{ch}-5$ spaces at end of last row. Fasten off $\mathbf{B}$, join $\mathbf{C}$.
Row 35: With C, repeat Row 3 - 10 dc ; 1 ch-3 space; 68 ch- 5 spaces at end of last row.

Row 36: Ch 3, 2 dc in first st, (sl st, ch 1,3 sc, ch $1, \mathrm{sl}$ st) in each ch-5 space across to next ch-3 space, (sl st, ch $1,2 \mathrm{sc}$, picot, 2 sc , ch 1 , sl st) in next ch-3 space, (sl st, ch 1,3 sc, ch 1 , sl st) in each ch-5 space across to last $3 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ dc in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
