**Red Heart® Soft®:** 2 balls 3729  
Grape A  
**and**  
**Red Heart® Boutique Sashay®:**  
2 balls 1960 Boogie B

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5.5mm [US I-9]

Sewing thread, sewing needle,  
yarn needle

**GAUGE:** (Shell, ch 2) = 1¼" (4½  
cm); 3 Shells rows = 2" (5 cm).  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any  
size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Crescent Shawl

*This beautifully designed shawl is shaped to wrap your shoulders in stylish comfort. Crochet it to finish a dressy outfit or to add feminine allure to more casual attire.*

**Finished Size:** 48" wide x 16" long [122 cm wide x 405/8 cm long]

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Shell:** (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in indicated stitch.

**V-st:** (1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) in indicated stitch.

**Ruffle sc:** \*Skip next mesh loop, go into indicated stitch and pull up a loop with next mesh loop (2 loops on hook), skip next mesh loop, with next mesh loop pull through 2 loops on hook (1 loop remaining—sc made).

## SHAWL

With **A**, ch 5, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Row 1 (Wrong side):** Ch 4 (counts as first dc throughout), 10 dc in ring, do not join, turn—11 dc.

**Row 2 (Right side):** Ch 4, 2 dc in each remaining dc across, turn—21 dc.

**Row 3:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, [skip 4 dc, ch 2, shell in next dc] 3 times, skip 4 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc, turn—3 shells, 6 dc.

**Row 4:** [(Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 space] (counts as first shell), [ch 2, shell in ch-2 space of next shell] 3 times, ch 2, [3 dc in last ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc] (counts as last shell), turn—5 shells.

**Row 5:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, [ch 2, shell in ch-2 space of next shell] 5 times, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc, turn—5 shells, 6 dc.

**Row 6:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, [ch 1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1, shell in ch-2 space of next shell] 5 times, ch 1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1, 3 dc in last dc, turn—5 shells, 12 dc.

**Row 7:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, skip 2 dc, [ch 1, V-st in next dc, ch 1, shell in ch-2 space of next shell] 5 times, ch 1, V-st in next dc, ch 1, 3 dc in last dc, turn—5 shells, 6 V-sts, 6 dc.

**Row 8:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in next dc, [3 dc in V-st, dc in each of next 6 dc] 5 times, 3 dc in V-st, 3 dc in next dc, 3 dc in last dc, turn—60 dc. Do not fasten off.

**Yarn Note:** Stretch one end of **B** open for 10" (25.5 cm) and lay flat, with the edge with the metallic thread at the bottom. Work stitches into the top two mesh loop threads of the yarn, leaving the metallic edge loose to form Ruffle. With wrong side of Shawl facing, join eighth mesh loop of **B** with slip st in end of row.

**Row 9 (Wrong side):** Ch 1, change to **B**, holding B in back of work, pull up a loop in 8th loop of mesh, work ruffle sc in first dc, [skip 1 dc, ruffle sc in next dc] across, ending with ruffle sc in last dc. Do not turn. Leaving a 4" (10 cm) end, fasten off—31 ruffle sc.

**Row 10 (Wrong side):** With wrong side facing, pick up A and slip st in first ruffle sc, (ch 4, 3 dc) in first ruffle sc, 2 dc in each of next 29 ruffle sc, 4 dc in last ruffle sc, turn—66 dc.

**Row 11 (Right side):** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, skip 2 dc, ch 2, shell in next dc, [ch 2, skip 5 dc, shell in next dc] 10 times, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc, turn—11 shells, 6 dc.

**Row 12:** [(Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in next dc] (counts as first shell), ch 2, [shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 2] 11 times, [3 dc in next dc, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc] (counts as last shell), turn—13 shells.

**Row 13:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, [shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1] 12 times, shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc, turn—13 shells, 18 dc.

**Row 14:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 1, V-st in ch-2 space, ch 1, [shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 1, V-st in next dc, ch 1] 12 times, shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 1, V-st in ch-2 space, ch 1, 3 dc in last dc, turn—13 shells, 14 V-sts, 6 dc.

**Row 15:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in next dc, 3 dc in V-st, [dc in each of next 6 dc, 3 dc in V-St] 13 times, 3 dc in next dc, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in last dc, turn—132 dc. Do not fasten off.

**Row 16 (Wrong side):** Ch 1, change to **B**, holding **B** in back of work, pull up a loop in 8th loop of mesh, work ruffle sc in first dc, [skip 1 dc, ruffle sc in next dc] across, ending with ruffle sc in last dc. Do not turn. Leaving a 4" (10 cm) end, fasten off—67 ruffle sc.

**Row 17 (Wrong side):** With wrong side facing, pick up **A** and slip st in first ruffle sc, (ch 4, 3 dc) in first ruffle sc, 2 dc in each of next 65 ruffle sc, 4 dc in last ruffle sc, turn—138 dc.

**Row 18 (Right side):** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, skip 2 dc, ch 2, shell in next dc, [ch 2, skip 5 dc, shell in next dc] 22 times, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc, turn—23 shells, 6 dc.

**Row 19:** [(Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in next dc] (counts as first shell), ch 2, [shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 2] 23 times, [3 dc in next dc, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc] (counts as last shell), turn—25 shells.

**Row 20:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, [shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1] 24 times, shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc, turn—25 shells, 30 dc.

**Row 21:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 1, V-st in ch-2 space, ch 1, [shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 1, V-st in next dc, ch 1] 24 times, shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 1, V-st in ch-2 space, ch 1, 3 dc in last dc, turn—25 shells, 26 V-sts, 6 dc.

**Row 22:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in next dc, 3 dc in V-st, [dc in each of next 6 dc, 3 dc in V-st] 25 times, 3 dc in next dc, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in last dc, turn—240 dc. Do not fasten off.

**Row 23 (Wrong side):** Ch 1, change to **B**, holding **B** in back of work, pull up a loop in 8th loop of mesh, work ruffle sc in first dc, [skip 1 dc, ruffle sc in next dc] across, ending with ruffle sc in last dc. Do not turn. Leaving a 4" (10 cm) end, fasten off—121 ruffle sc.

**Row 24 (Wrong side):** With wrong side facing, pick up **A** and slip st in first ruffle sc, (ch 4, 3 dc) in first ruffle sc, 2 dc in each of next 119 ruffle sc, 4 dc in last ruffle sc, turn—246 dc.

**Row 25 (Right side):** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, skip 2 dc, ch 2, shell in next dc, [ch 2, skip 5 dc, shell in next dc] 40 times, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc, turn—41 shells, 6 dc.

**Row 26:** [(Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in next dc] (counts as first shell), ch 2, [shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 2] 41 times, [3 dc in next dc, ch 2, 3 dc in last dc] (counts as last shell), turn—43 shells.

**Row 27:** (Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, [shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 2] 43 times, 3 dc in last dc, turn—43 shells, 6 dc.

**Row 28:** [(Ch 4, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in next dc] (counts as first shell), [shell in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 2] 43 times, [3 dc in next dc, skip 1 dc, 3 dc in last dc] (counts as last shell), turn—45 shells.

**Row 29:** Ch 1, fasten off **A**, change to **B**, holding **B** in back of work, pull up a loop in 8th loop of mesh, ruffle sc in first dc, \*ruffle sc in next dc, skip next dc, ruffle sc in ch-2 space, skip next dc; repeat from \* across, ending with ruffle sc in last dc. Leaving a 4" (10 cm) end, fasten off.

## EDGING

With right side facing, join **A** with slip st in end of last row, ch 1, work sc evenly across to center, sc in beginning ring, sc evenly across remaining row ends. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

To finish the ends of **B**, fold mesh yarn over the sc edging and tack to WS with sewing needle and thread. Weave in all ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); yo = yarn over; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
