What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball 9440
Light Grey Heather A
RED HEART® Boutique Filigree: 1
ball 9941 Urban B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6.5mm [K-10.5 US]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" (10 cm) in
pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**
Use any size hook to obtain the
gauge.

Ribbon Shawl

Instead of making ruffles with the Filigree yarn, cut it into strips and crochet lacy inserts between the strips. This is a wonderful way to create a shawl with beautiful texture.

Shawl measures 60" long x 26" wide
(152.5 x 66 cm)

Notes

1. Lay out a section of the ribbon yarn with the closer spaced holes on the top edge and the wider spaced holes on the bottom edge. Note that it has open mesh areas with 4 rows of holes across width of ribbon. On the bottom edge, there are randomly placed large holes, but the next row up has the same four small holes as the top edge. For the purposes of this pattern, skip the row with the large holes and crochet into the row of smaller holes.
2. You will need to measure out and cut five 54" (137 cm) strips of **B** with 40 sets of mesh holes in each strip. Cut through vertical bars so that the holes are left intact; the cut bars are not included in the bar count.
3. When stitching across ends of rows, work over cut ends of vertical bars into first row of holes.
4. Working to the same number of stitches as shown in the stitch count not as critical as working to the "multiple of 4 + 2 stitches" in each row. Depending on how accurately you cut **B**, you may have more or less stitches than shown in the stitch count. However, Row 1 of side edging must equal 42 stitches.

SHAWL

Join **A** with slip st to first hole in top right corner of **B**.

Row 1 (right side): Skip next hole, sc in next hole, *ch 3, skip next vertical bar, sc in first and 3rd hole of next 4-hole group; repeat from * across, turn—82 sc (or multiple of 4 + 2).

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout) skip first sc, dc in next sc, *ch 3, sc in next 2 sc, ch 3, dc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across, turn—42 dc and 40 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first 2 dc, *ch 6, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 2 dc; repeat from * across, turn—42 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, *ch 8, sc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across, turn—42 sc and 10 ch-8 spaces.

Row 5 (Joining Row): Hold next strip of **B** behind last row with wider bottom holes facing, ch 3, slip st in 3rd hole of first 4-hole group, skip first sc, dc in next sc, *ch 3, sc in next ch-8 space, slip st in 3rd hole of next 4-hole group, sc in same ch-8 space, ch 3, dc in next sc, slip st in 3rd hole of next 4-hole group, dc in next sc; repeat from * across. Fasten off.

Join **A** with slip st to first hole in top right corner of current strip of **B**.

Repeat Rows 1–5 until all strips are joined.

Top Edging

Rows 1–4: Repeat Rows 1–4 of shawl.

Row 5: Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in next dc, *ch 3, 2 sc in next ch-8 space, ch 3, dc in next two dc; repeat from * across. Fasten off.

Bottom Edging

Hold shawl with bottom edge of **B** facing. Work same as Rows 1–5 of top edging.

SHOP KIT

Side Edging

With right side and ends of rows facing, join **A** with slip st to last st of Row 5 of edging

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, working across ends of rows, sc in next row, ch 3, sc in next 2 rows, ch 3, sc in next row, sc in first hole of next strip, ch 3, sc in 5th and 6th holes of same strip, ch 3, sc in last hole of same strip, [sc in next row, ch 3, skip next row, sc in next 2 rows, ch 3, sc in next row, sc in first hole of next strip, ch 3, sc in 5th and 6th holes of same strip, ch 3, sc in last hole of same strip] twice, [sc in next row, ch 3, skip next row, sc in next 2 rows, ch 3, sc in next row, sc in first hole of next strip, ch 3, sc in 5th and 6th holes of same strip, ch 3] twice, sc in next 2 rows, ch 3, skip next row, sc in last 2 rows—42 sc.

Rows 2–5: Repeat Rows 2–5 of top edging. Fasten off.

Repeat for second side, turn, and do not fasten off at the end of Row 5.

Border

Round 1: Ch 1, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in each corner dc and in each ch-3 space; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Lightly steam block, if necessary.
Weave in ends.

A, B = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **sp(s)** = space(s); **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
