## What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 3 skeins of 319 Cherry Red OR

RED HEART® Super Saver®
Jumbo: 2 skeins of 319 Cherry

Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks: 6mm [US J-10]

GAUGE: 12 sts and 8 rows = 4" (10 cm) in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins OR

color 14 oz, (396 g), 744 yd (681 m) and 10 oz multicolor (283 g), 482 yd (440 m) skeins



# Ruffled Wrap

This shawl has a feminine edge and spans the seasons beautifully. Wear it as an extra layer to keep your neck warm in the winter, instead of a sweater in the spring or fall, and over bare shoulders in the summer.

SHOP KIT

Shawl measures 17" (43 cm) x 60" (152.5 cm) One Size Fits All.

### **Special Abbreviation**

**3-dc Cluster:** [Yarn over, insert hook in next st, yarn over and draw upa loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times in same st, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

## **SHAWL**

Ch 40.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—39 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 here and throughout), skip first 2 sc, \*dc in next sc, ch 1, skip next sc; rep from \* across to last sc, dc in last sc, turn—19 ch-1 spaces.

Row 4: Ch 4, skip next ch-1 space, \*3-dc cluster in next dc, ch 1, skip next ch-1 space; repeat from \* across to turning ch, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn—18 clusters.

Row 5: Ch 4, skip next ch-1 space, \*dc in next cluster, ch 1, skip next ch-1 space; rep from \* across, to turning ch, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn—19 ch-1 spaces.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first dc, \*sc in next ch-1 space, sc in next dc; repeat from \* across, ending with last sc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn—39 sc.

Rows 7–8: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Repeat Rows 3–8 until piece measures 56" (142 cm) from beginning. Fasten off.

## **Ruffled Border**

Row 1: With right side facing, join yarn in top right-hand corner with a slip st, ch 1, 3 sc in same st, \*working across long edge of wrap, work 1 sc in each row-end sc and 2 sc in each row-end dc or ch-3 space to next corner, 3 sc in next corner\*, working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in each ch across, 3 sc in next corner; repeat from \* to \* once, sc

in each st across top edge of wrap; join with a slip st in first sc.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in first sc, 2 dc in each sc around; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in first st, 2 dc in each dc around; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten Off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
