



## Stars Over the Sea Shawl

*Try this interesting Star Mesh stitch pattern while you create a wonderful lightweight shawl. Crocheted in fine yarn, it works up more quickly than thread and is perfect for cool spring and summer evenings.*

Designed by Kristen Stoltzfus.

**Shawl measures 14½" (37 cm) wide x 52" (132 cm) long.**

**RED HEART® LusterSheen®:** 3 skeins 0995 Ocean.

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 3.5mm [US E-4].  
Tapestry needle, rust-proof pins.

**GAUGE:** 6 sts = 4"; 6 rows = 4" in Star Mesh pattern.  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Star Mesh** = [yo] twice, insert hook next st and draw up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops on hook (first leg of st), yo, skip next st or space, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, [yo, draw through 2 loops on hook] 4 times (2nd and 3rd legs of st), ch 1, dc in center of this st where legs meet (4th leg of st).

**Triple picot** = [ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook] 3 times.

### SHAWL

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Ch 92 loosely; tr in 5th ch from hook and in each ch across; turn – 89 tr.

**Rows 2-4:** Ch 4 (counts as tr), skip first tr, tr in each tr across and in top of ch-4; turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 1), skip first 2 tr, Star Mesh over next 3 tr, [ch 1, skip next tr, Star Mesh over next 3 tr] 21 times; turn – 22 Star Mesh.

**Row 6:** Ch 5, skip first space, [Star Mesh (work first leg into next st of Star Mesh in row below, skip next ch-1 space, and work 2nd leg into next st of next Star Mesh in row below), ch 1, skip next space] 21 times, ch 1, Star Mesh over last 3 sts: (work first leg next st of Star Mesh in row below, skip next ch of ch-5, and work 2nd leg into 4th ch of ch-5); turn.

Repeat Row 6 for Star Mesh pattern until piece measures 52" from beginning, end wrong side row.

**Next Row:** Ch 4, skip first st, tr in each st and space across; turn – 89 tr.

**Next 3 Rows:** Ch 4, skip first tr, tr in each st across; turn.

### EDGING

**Round 1:** Ch 3, 6 dc in first st, ch 3, \* skip next st, sc in next st, \*\* skip next 2 sts, 5 dc in next st, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st; repeat from \*\* across to last 2 sts; skip next st, 7 dc in last st \*; *working along long side:* sc in side of next row, \*\*\* 5 dc in side of next row, sc in side of next row; repeat from \*\*\* across long side \*\*\*\*; 7 dc in first st of short



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side; *working on opposite of foundation ch*: repeat from \* to \*, then repeat from \*\*\* to \*\*\*\*; join with a slip st in top of ch-3.

**Round 2:** \* Slip st to center dc of next shell, (triple picot, slip st) all in same st, slip st to next sc, sc in sc; repeat from \* around; join with a slip st in first slip st. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

**Abbreviations:** **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **tr** = treble crochet; **yo** = yarn over; \* or \*\* or \*\*\* or \*\*\*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* or \*\*\* or \*\*\*\* as indicated; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
