# On the Town Shawl

Perfect any time of the year, this shimmering crocheted shawl will complete your look and keep you comfortable. Wear it over casual and dressy outfits, or even for your wedding day.

Designed by Julie Farmer.

Wrap measures 15" wide x 54" long without edging.

**RED HEART® Shimmer**<sup>™</sup>: 3 balls 1113 Ivory.

Crochet Hook: 4mm [US G-6].

Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 6 V-sts = 4"; 6 rows = 4" in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

### Special Abbreviations

**V-st** = (tr, ch 2, tr) in same st or space.

**Shell** = (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same st or space.

#### **WRAP**

Ch 66.

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn – 65 sc.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as tr), skip first 2 sc, \*V-st in next sc, skip next 2 sc; repeat from \* to last 3 sc; V-st in next sc, skip next sc, tr in last sc; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 4, \* V-st in ch-2 space of next V-st; repeat from \* to last st; tr in top of ch- 4; turn.

Repeat Row 3 for pattern until 54" from beginning.

**Last Row:** Ch 1, sc in each st and ch across. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## EDGING (Make 2)

**Note:** Edging is made separately and sewn on to both short ends.

Ch 14.


Row 1 (Wrong Side): Dc in 8th ch from hook, ch 2, skip next 2 ch, shell in next ch, ch 2, skip next 2 ch, dc in last ch; turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 5, (counts as dc, ch 2), shell in ch-2 space of shell, dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, skip ch-2, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in 5th ch of beginning ch-7 (hereafter dc in next dc); turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 5, skip first dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next 4 dc, shell in ch-2 space, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of ch-5; turn.

Row 4: Ch 5, shell in ch-2 space of shell, dc in next 6 dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, (dc, [ch 2, dc] 6 times) all in next space, ch 2, slip st in turning ch-5 of first row (hereafter slip st in base of dc); turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 5, sc in first ch-2 space, [(sc, ch 5, sc) in next ch-2 space] 7 times, ch 3, skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, skip next 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, shell in ch-2 space of shell, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of ch-5; turn.








## **ON THE TOWN SHAWL | CROCHET**

Repeat Rows 2-5 six more times. Do not turn at end of last row but pivot to work edging: ch 1, sc evenly across long top edge; turn. Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Fasten off. Weave in ends. Sew edging to both short sides of wrap.



**RED HEART® Shimmer™**, Art. E763 available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 28 yd (256 m) balls.

ABBREVIATIONS: ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble crochet; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.



THIS PATTERN NEEDS A MULTIPLE OF 3 STS PLUS 2 STS. 63 STS + 2 = 65 STS WORKS (CH 66).
