## What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love®:**  
4 skeins 1933 Echo

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
4mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 3¾ sts = 4" [10  
cm]; 5¼ rows = 4" [10 cm] in  
pattern stitch. **CHECK YOUR  
GAUGE. Use any size hook  
to obtain the gauge.**

# Arrow Stitch Shawl

This shawl is a straight shot to keeping fashionably warm. It's a great project for variegated and solid colors of With Love.

Pick your favorite and get stitching.

**Shawl measures 20" [51 cm] wide x 70" [178 cm] long.**

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Tri st (Triangle stitch):** Ch 6, sc in 3rd chain from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in last ch, do not turn.

## SHAWL

Ch 97.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*Tri st, skip 4 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from \* across – 19 Tri sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 7 (counts as dtr and ch 2 here and throughout), turn, sc in skipped ch-2 of next Tri st, \*ch 4, sc in skipped ch-2 of next Tri st; repeat from \* across, ch 2, dtr in last sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dtr, \*Tri st, sc in next ch-4 space; repeat from \* across, working last sc in 5th ch of beg ch-7.

**Row 4:** Ch 7, turn, sc in sc in skipped ch-2 of next Tri st, \*ch 4, sc in skipped ch-2 of next Tri st; repeat from \* across, ch 2, dtr in last sc.

Repeat Rows 3-4 for 44 more times or until piece measures 70" [178 cm] from beginning. Do not fasten off.

## FINISHING

**Edging:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in each ch-sp and st across top edge, 3 hdc in corner, turn to work along side edge, hdc evenly spaced along side edge, working 5 hdc in each dtr row and hdc in each sc row to next corner, 3 hdc in corner, turn to work along opposite edge of foundation ch, work 94 hdc evenly spaced along edge, 3 hdc in corner, turn to work along opposite side edge, hdc evenly spaced along side edge, working 5 hdc in each dtr row and hdc in each sc row to next corner, 3 hdc in corner, slip st in top of beginning ch-2.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

**ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **dtr** = double treble crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = triple or treble crochet; \* **or** \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.



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
