What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver Ombre™, 2 skeins 3962
True Blue

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5mm [US J-10]

Stitch markers, yarn needle

GAUGE: One pattern repeat = 3½" [9 cm]; 4 rows = 4" [10 cm] at shell points. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Comfortable Color Shawl

This shawl really lets the beauty of Super Saver Ombre shine. Worked in a lacy shell pattern, it drapes beautifully, too.

Shawl measures 15" [38 cm] x 72" [183 cm].

NOTES

Shawl is worked in two halves. First Half is worked from center out to one short end. Second Half stitches are picked up along center edge and are worked to opposite short end. This allows both short ends to have a scalloped edge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

V-st: (Dc, ch 1, dc) all in same st or space.

Shell: (Hdc, 2 dc, hdc) all in same space.

SHAWL First Half

Ch 54.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Dc in 6th ch from hook (counts as first V-st), *ch 2, skip next 5 ch, ([dc, ch 2] 3 times, dc) all in next ch, ch 2, skip next 5 ch, V-st in next ch; repeat from * across; turn.

Row 2 (Mark as right side): Ch 4, dc in first ch-1 space (counts as first V-st here and throughout), *skip next ch-2 space, [Shell in next ch-2 space] 3 times, skip next ch-2 space, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st; repeat from * across, working last V-st in ch-4 space; turn.

Row 3: Ch 4, dc in ch-1 space of first V-st, *ch 2, skip next Shell, ([dc, ch 2] 3 times, dc) all in first dc of next Shell, ch 2, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st; repeat from * across, working last V-st in ch-4 space; turn.

Repeat Rows 2-3 until piece measures 36" [91.5 cm], end with Row 2. Fasten off.

Second Half

Turn to work across opposite edge of foundation ch.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): With wrong side facing, join yarn in first ch with a slip st, ch 4, dc in same ch, *ch 2, skip next 5 ch, ([dc, ch 2] 3 times, dc) all in next ch, ch 2, skip next 5 ch, V-st in next ch; repeat from * across; turn.

Repeat Rows 2-3 as for First Half until piece measures 36" [91.5 cm] from center seam, end with Row 2. Do not fasten off.

Edging Row: With right side facing, turn to work along long edge, ch 1, sc over end of last row, *(sc, ch 2, sc) over end of next row; repeat from * across to opposite end. Fasten off.

With right side facing, join yarn in corner along opposite long side with a slip st, repeat Edging Row.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

ch = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
