



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

### ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rem** = Remaining

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**WS** = Wrong side

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 62" [156.5 cm] long (across between points) x 18" [45.5 cm] wide, excluding fringe.

### GAUGE

12 dc and 6 rows = 4" [10 cm].

### INSTRUCTIONS

**Stripe Pat:** 4 rows with A.

2 rows with B.

These 6 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, leaving 6" [15 cm] end at beg of chain, ch 199 (counts as first row of Stripe Pat).

**1st row:** (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and each of next 3 ch. Skip next 2 ch. Sl st in next ch. \*Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 4 ch. Skip next 2 ch. Sl st in next ch. Rep from \* to end of chain. Fasten off, leaving 6" [15 cm] end. Turn.



### MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver Metallic™** (5 oz/142 g; 255 yds/233 m)

**Contrast A** White (0310)

**2 balls**

**Contrast B** Fuchsia (0370)

**1 ball**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

**2nd row:** (WS). With A, leaving 6" [15 cm] end at beg of chain, ch 7. Skip first 4 dc. Join with sl st in top of next ch-3 sp. \*Ch 7. Skip next 4 dc. Sl st in top of next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* to last 4-dc group. Ch 7. Turn.



**3rd row:** (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and each of next 3 ch. Skip next sl st and 2 ch. Sl st in next ch. \*Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 4 ch. Skip next sl st and 2 ch. Sl st in next ch. Rep from \* to last 4 ch. Ch 3. 1 dc in each of last 4 ch. Fasten off, leaving 6" [15 cm] end. Turn.



**4th and 5th rows:** With B, rep 2nd and 3rd rows.

First 6 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep 2nd and 3rd rows until work from beg measures approx 18" [45.5 cm], ending with 4 rows of A. Fasten off.

**Fringe:** Cut strands of yarn 14" [35.5 cm] long. Taking 2 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe across both ends of Scarf using corresponding colors and taking loose 6" [15 cm] ends of yarn into fringe. Trim fringe evenly.
