MATERIALS Red Heart® Unforgettable™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 270 yds/247 m) Sizes L XL 2/3XL 4/5XL Echo (3940) balls Size U.S. D/3 [3.25 mm] crochet hook or sizes needed to obtain

Dc2tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next st. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

Dbl Lk (Double Love Knot) =

*Pull loop up ¾" [2 cm]. Yoh and draw through loop (long chain), insert hook under back strand of loop. Yoh and draw through. Yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Rep from * once more.

Lk (Love Knot) = Pull loop up 34" [2 cm]. Yoh and draw through loop (long chain). Insert hook under back strand of loop. Yoh and draw under back strand of loop. Yoh and draw through 2 loops (sc made in back of long ch).

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

SI st = Slip stitch

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GAUGE

4 Double Love Knots and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Notes:

- Jacket is worked in three pieces: Body and two sleeves.
- Body is worked in one piece beginning at lower back edge. Work is divided at back neck then left and right fronts are worked down to lower front edge.
- Front ties are worked as part of the front sections.
- Sleeves are worked separately and sewn to the body.
- Be careful when checking gauge, using a significantly larger hook thana 3.25mm [D-3] hook could make the knots within the Love Knots too loose.

- There is no right or wrong side to a Love Knot. Accordingly, the two fronts can be started at outer edge of opposite shoulders.
- Jacket is intended to have about 2" [5 cm] of ease.

JACKET

Back

Foundation Row: Ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook, make 36 (40-44-48-52-56) Lk. Turn.

1st row: Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook. *Dbl Lk. Skip next 2 loops. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. 1 Lk. Turn. 18 (20-22-24-26-28) Dbl Lk and 1 Lk.

Rep 1st row until work from beg measures approx 31" [78.5 cm]. PM at sc at top of last Lk of 2nd to last row. This is where you will rejoin yarn for beg of Right Front.

Divide for Back Neck Left Front

1st row: 1 Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook. (1 Dbl Lk. skip next 2 loops. 1 sc in next sc) 5 (6-7-8-9-10) times. 1 Lk. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked for back neck and Right Front. 6 (7-8-9-10-11) Dbl Lk and 1 Lk.

2nd to 12th rows: 1 Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook. *1 Dbl Lk. Skip next 2 loops. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. 1 Lk. Turn.

13th row: (Inc row). 1 Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook. *1 Dbl Lk. Skip next 2 loops. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Dbl Lk. Skip only 1 loop. 1 tr in next sc. Ch 1. 1 Lk. Turn. 7 (8-9-10-11-12) Dbl Lk and 1 Lk.

14th row: 1 Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook (skipping additional ch 1-sp at beg of row). *1 Dbl Lk. Skip next 2 loops. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. 1 Lk. Turn.

15th to 20th rows: As 13th and 14th rows 3 times more. **10** (**11-12-13-14-15**) Dbl Lk and 1 Lk.

21st and 22nd rows: As 2nd row.

23rd row: (Beg of Front tie). 1 Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook. *1 Dbl Lk. Skip next 2 loops. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Make 23 Lk. Turn.

24th to 30th rows: 1 Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook. *1 Dbl Lk. Skip next 2 loops. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row 1 Lk. Turn. 21 (22-23-24-25-26) Dbl Lk and 1 Lk.

31st row: (End of front tie). 1 Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook. (1 Dbl Lk. Skip next 2 loops, sc in next sc) **10** (11-12-13-14-15) times. 1 Lk. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked **11** (12-13-14-15-16) Dbl Lk and 1 Lk.

32nd row: 1 Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook. *1 Dbl Lk. Skip next 2 loops. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. 1 Lk.

Rep 32nd row until front has same number of rows as back, omitting 1 Lk at end of last row. Fasten off.

Right Front

Join yarn with sl st at marked sc. 1 Lk. Work as given for Left Front. Fasten off.



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SLEEVES

Foundation row: Ch 2. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Make 28 (30-32-34-36-40) Lk. Turn.

1st row: 1 Dbl Lk. 1 sc in sc between 4th and 5th loops from hook. *1 Dbl Lk. Skip next 2 loops. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from *to end of row. 1 Lk. Turn. 14 (15-16-17-18-20) Dbl Lk and 1 Lk.

Rep 1st row until work from beg measures approx 23" [58.5 cm], omitting 1 Lk at end of last row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Place markers on side edges of fronts and back 6½ (7-7½-8-8½-9½)" [16.5 (18-19-20.5-21.5-24) cm] from shoulders. Sew sleeves between markers. Fold fronts over back, matching all edges. Sew sleeve and side seams.

Note: For best results, designer recommends matching outer knots along edges. Sew one set of knots tog then extend the sewing yarn to reach the next set of outer knots without bunching the edges

or leaving an overly loose loop of sewing yarn.

Edging: With RS facing, join yarn with sl st in lower corner where one front tie meets front edge.


1st row: (RS). Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1). 1 dc in next loop. *Ch 1. 1 dc in next loop. Rep from * around, working [(1 dc. Ch 1) twice. 1 dc) in each outer corner and dc2tog over 2 loops (skipping sc between) at each inner corner. Join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.






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Note: Fronts are mirror-images. In this schematic, the first front is shown overlapping the second front.
