RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\oplus}$ : 1 skein each 365 Coffee A, 947 Marrakesh B and 254 Pumpkin C

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9]

Two decorative buttons, stitch markers, yarn needle

GAUGE: $11 \mathrm{dc}=4$ " [ 10 cm ]; 6 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Crochet Trapeze Jacket

Crochet this sleeveless jacket in coordinating shades as shown or in any colors that you please! It's a superb way to add new fashion style to your wardrobe.

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium, Large, X -Large and 2 X are in parentheses.

Bust: 38 (42, 46, 50, 54)" [96.5 (106.5, 117, $127,137) \mathrm{cm}]$
Length: 24 (24, 26, 26, 28)" [61 (61, 66, 66, 71) cm ]

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

WP: Ch 6, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next ch, dtr in next ch.

## JACKET

## Left Armhole

With A, ch 50 ( $50,60,60,74$ ), slip st in first ch to join, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.
Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in each ch around, join with slip st in top of beginning ch $-50(50,60,60$, 74) dc.

## Upper Back

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in next $24(24,30,30,36)$ dc, leave remaining sts unworked - $25(25,31$, $31,37) \mathrm{dc}$.
Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in each dc.
Repeat Row 2 for 1 (1, 2, 2, 3) more rows. Cut A.
Change to $\mathbf{B}$ and repeat Row 2 for 4 rows. Cut B.
Change to $\mathbf{C}$ and repeat Row 2 for 5 rows. Fasten off.

## Right Armhole

With A, ch 50 (50, 60, 60, 74), slip st in first ch to join, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.
Round 1: Ch 3, dc in each ch around, join with slip st in top of beginning ch - $50(50,60,60$, 74) dc.

## Upper Back

Row 1: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 24 (24, 30, 30,
36) dc, leave remaining sts unworked - 25 $(25,31,31,37)$ dc.
Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in each dc.
Repeat Row 2 for $1(1,2,2,3)$ more rows. Cut A.
Change to C and repeat Row 2 for 4 rows. Cut C.
Change to B and repeat Row 2 for 5 rows. Fasten off.

Joining Row: With rights sides together and working through both layers of Upper Back, join C in first st, sc in each st across to join. Fasten off.

## Lower Back

Row 1: With wrong side facing and working along lower edge of Upper Back, join A in edge of first st on Row 1 of Right Armhole, ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc 48 $(54,60,66,72)$ sts evenly spaced to edge of first st on Row 1 of Left Armhole - 49 (55, 61, $67,73)$ hdc.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *WP, skip next 5 sts, sc in next st; repeat from * across - 8 $(9,10,11,12)$ WP sts. Cut A.
Row 3: Change to $\mathbf{B}$, ch 5 (counts as dtr here and throughout), turn, *working along opposite edge of ch of first WP, sc in first 2 chs , hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next ch, dtr in next ch, skip next sc; repeat from * across, dtr in last sc.
Row 4: With B, repeat Row 2. Cut B.
Row 5: Change to C and repeat Row 3.
Row 6: With C, repeat Row 2. Cut C.
Row 7: Change to A and repeat Row 3.
Row 8: Ch 4 (counts as tr here and
throughout), turn, tr in each st across - 49 (55, $61,67,73$ ) tr. Cut A.

Row 9: Change to $\mathbf{B}$, ch 4, turn, tr in each tr across
Row 10: Repeat Row 2. Cut B.
Row 11: With C, repeat Row 3.
Row 12: Repeat Row 2. Cut C.
Row 13: With A, repeat Row 3.
Row 14: Repeat Row 2. Cut A.
Row 15: With B, repeat Row 3.
Row 16: Ch 4, turn, tr into each st across. Cut B.
Row 17: With C, repeat Row 9.
Do not fasten off.

## Right Front Bodice

Row 1 (Right Side): With right side facing, turn to work along side edge of Back, ch 1, hdc 38 sts evenly along edge of lower back to first unworked st of Armhole, hdc in remaining $25(25,31,31,37)$ unworked dc of Right Armhole - 63 ( $63,69,69,75$ ) hdc.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc into first st, *WP, skip next 5 sts, sc into next st; repeat from * across to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts -10 ( 10 , $11,11,12)$ WP sts. Cut C.
Row 3: Change to B, ch 5, turn, dtr in next 2 sts, *working along opposite edge of ch of first WP, sc in first 2 chs, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next ch, dtr in next ch, skip next sc; repeat from * across, dtr in last sc.
Row 4: With B, repeat Row 2. Cut B
Row 5: Change to $A$ and repeat Row 3
Row 6: Ch 4, turn, tr into each st across - 63 $(63,69,69,75)$ tr. Cut A.
Row 7: Change to C, ch 4, turn, tr in each st across.
Repeat Rows 2-7 until piece measures 10 $(11,12,13,14)$ " $[25(28,30,33,36) \mathrm{cm}]$ from Row 1.
Fasten off.

## Left Front Bodice

Row 1 (Wrong Side): With wrong side facing, join A at lower side edge of Back, ch 1, hdc 38 sts evenly along edge of lower back to first unworked st of Armhole, hdc in remaining 25
$(25,31,31,37)$ unworked dc of right armhole - 63 (63, 69, 69, 75) hdc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc into first st, *WP, skip next 5 sts, sc into next st; repeat from * across to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts - 10 (10, $11,11,12)$ WP sts. Cut A
Row 3: Change to C, ch 5, turn, dtr in next 2 sts, *working along opposite edge of ch of first WP, sc in first 2 chs, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next ch, dtr in next ch, skip next sc; repeat from * across, dtr in last sc.
Row 4: With C, repeat Row 2. Cut C.
Row 5: Change to B and repeat Row 3
Row 6: Ch 4, turn, tr into each st across - 63 (63, 69, 69, 75) tr. Cut B.
Row 7: Change to $A$, ch 4, turn, tr in each st across.
Repeat Rows 2-7 until piece measures 10 $(11,12,13,14) "[25(28,30,33,36) \mathrm{cm}]$ from Row 1.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Mark $4 ½(41 ⁄ 2,5,5,5 ½) "[11.5(11.5,12.5$, $12.5,14) \mathrm{cm}]$ from side edges on Fronts and Back for Shoulders, leaving center 7" [18 cm ] along top edge of Back and remaining top edge of Front unsewn for Neck.

## Join Shoulders

With right sides together and working through both layers, join C where marked and sc first Shoulder closed. Leave center 7" [18 cm ] of Back and remaining edges of Front unsewn. Fasten off.
Repeat for opposite Shoulder.

## Edging

With right side facing, join A at lower side seam edge, ch 1, sc evenly around lower, front and neck edges of piece, slip st to first st to join.
Fasten off.
Sew one button in center of unsewn Front neck edge on Left Front. Sew second button 3 " [ 8 cm ] down from Neck edge along front edge. Use spaces between sts as buttonholes.

Weave in ends.
