Lake House Hat & Scarf

NO109



INTERMEDIATE

Designed by Ellen Gormley.

Scarf measures 6" wide x 29½" long.
Hat measures 21½" in circumference.

STITCH NATION by Debbie Stoller™ "Alpaca Love™": 2 balls 3350 Espresso A, and 1 ball 3810 Lake B.

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9] and 6.5mm [US K-10 ½].
Yarn needle, 1¼" button.

GAUGE: With larger hook, 15 sts = 4"; 0 rows = 4". With smaller hook, first 4 rounds of hat = 4" in diameter. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

FBtr2tog (Front and Back tr2tog): yo twice, insert hook in specified st working in front of the previous row, yo, draw through st, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice (2 loops remain on hook), yo twice, insert hook in same st working behind the previous row, yo, draw through st, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice (3 loops remain on hook), yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

NOTE

Scarf is worked with both colors simultaneously carry along and work over the unused color.

HAT

With smaller hook and A, ch 4, join with slip st in first ch to form ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring, join with a slip st in first sc – 8 sc.

Round 2: Ch 2 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in same st, 2 dc in each dc around, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 – 16 dc.

Round 3: Ch 2, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; repeat from * around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 – 24 dc.

Round 4: Ch 2, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, *dc in each of next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from * around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 – 32 dc.

Round 5: Ch 2, dc in each of next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st; *dc in each of next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 – 40 dc.

Round 6: Ch 2, dc in each of next 3 sts, 2 dc in next; *dc in each of next 4 sts, 2 dc in next dc; repeat from * around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 – 48 dc.

Round 7: Ch 2, dc in each of next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st; *dc in each of next 5 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from * around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 – 56 dc.

Round 8: Ch 2, dc in each of next 5 sts, 2 dc in next st; *dc in each of next 6 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from * around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 – 64 dc.

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Round 9: Ch 2, dc in each of next 6 sts, 2 dc in next st; *dc in each of next 7 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from * around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 – 72 dc.

Round 10: Ch 2, dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 – 72 dc.

Round 11: Ch 1, sc in same st, ch 1, skip next st, *sc in next st, ch 1, skip next st; repeat from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 36 sc; 36 ch-1 spaces.

Round 12: Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 1), skip next st; *tr in next st, ch 1, skip next st; repeat from * around; join with sl st in 4th ch of beginning ch-5 – 36 tr; 36 ch-1 spaces, switching to B in last st, drop A, do not cut.

Round 13: With B, ch 1, sc in first st, *FBtr2tog in unused st 2 rounds below**, sc in next st on current rnd; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; join with sl st in first sc, switching to A in last st – 36 sc; 36 FBtr2tog.

Round 14: With A, repeat round 11.

Round 15: With A, repeat round 12.

Round 16: With B, repeat round 13.

Round 17: With A, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc – 72 sc. Fasten off.

SCARF

With larger hook and A, ch 16.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 15 sc.

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 1), skip next st, *tr in next st, ch 1, skip next st; repeat from * across to last st, tr in last st, switching to B in last st, turn – 8 tr; 7 ch-1 spaces.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, *FBtr2tog in unused sc 2 rows below, sc in next tr on current row; repeat from * across, switching to A in last st, turn – 7 FBtr2tog; 8 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first st, *ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st; repeat from * across, switching to B in last st, turn – 8 sc, 7 ch-1 spaces.

Row 5: Ch 5 (counts as tr plus 1 ch), *skip next st, tr in next st, ch 1; repeat from * across to last st, tr in last st, switching to A in last st, turn – 8 tr, 7 ch-1 spaces.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in same st, *FBtr2tog in unused st 2 rows below, sc in next tr on current row; repeat from * across, switching to B in last st, turn – 7 FBtr2tog; 8 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first st, *ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st; repeat from * across, switching to A in last st, turn – 8 sc; 7 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 8-49: Repeat rows 2-7, 7 times.

Rows 50-53: Repeat rows 2-5.

Row 54: (buttonhole row) Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, *FBtr2tog in unused sc 2 rows below, sc in next tr on current row*; repeat from

* to * 3 times, sc in next ch-1 space, sc in next st; repeat from * to * 3 times, switching to B in last st, turn – 6 FBtr2tog; 9 sc.

Row 55: Repeat row 7.

Rows 56-60: Repeat rows 2-6, do not change color after row 60. Do not fasten off.

Edging

Round 1: With A, ch 1, sc in each st across top edge (15 sc), working along long side edge, work 81 sc evenly spaced across, working across foundation row, sc in each ch across (15 sc), working along long side, work 81 sc evenly spaced across, join with sl st in first sc – 192 sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, ch 2, *sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, ch 2; repeat from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 64 repeats. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

FINISHING

With needle and matching thread sew button onto stitch number 8 of row 9 on right side of scarf.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B, C = color A, B, C; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble crochet; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
