## What you will need:

Red Heart® Chic Sheep by Marly Bird™: 3 balls of 5316 Linen A, 2 balls of 5687 VIP B, 1 ball of 5681 Suite **C** 

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 16 linked double crochet = 4" (10 cm): 9 rows = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# **BUY YARN**



RED HEART® Chic Sheep by Marly Bird™, Art. R170 100% Merino Wool available 3.5 oz (100 g), 186 vd (170 m) balls



#### Projects measure:

Hat: 8" [20.5 cm] in length and 22" [56 cm1 in circumference for hat.

**Scarf:** 6" [15 cm] in width and 68" [173 cm] in length including fringe.

Mitts: 10.5" [26.5 cm] in length and 9"

[23 cm] in circumference.

#### **Pattern Notes**

Unless otherwise indicated, all stitches are worked on the same side of the fabric fastening off at the end of each row.

## **Special Stitches**

Linked double crochet (ldc): Insert hook through horizontal bar on the front of last st made, yo and pull up a loop, insert hook in next stitch indicated, yo and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook1 twice.

Join with double crochet: Yo and insert the hook in stitch indicated (being careful that the yo doesn't untwist from the hook), [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

Cable: Skip next 2 stitches, fpdc around the next stitch, bpdc around 2nd skipped st, fpdc around 1st skipped st (in front of first fpdc)

Front Post Double Crochet (fpdc): Yo, insert hook from the front around post of stitch indicated, yo and pull up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

Back Post Double Crochet (bpdc): Yo. insert hook from the back around post of stitch indicated, yo and pull up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

#### Reverse Single Crochet (reverse sc):

Working from left to right, insert hook from front to back in next stitch to the right, yo and pull loop through stitch, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook.

## SCARF

**Note:** The cabled center column is stitched first, then the stripes are stitched on either side of the cabled center column.

#### Center Column

With A. Ch 7.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped ch count as dc) and in each ch across. Do not fasten off throughout center column. Turn - 5 dc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), bpdc around next dc, fpdc around next dc, bpdc around next dc, hdc in top of tch.

Row 3: Ch 2, cable across next 3 sts, hdc in top of tch. Turn.

Rows 4-158: Repeat Rows 2-3 (ending with a Row 2). Fasten off.

## Stripes

**Note:** Turn project sideways and begin working over row ends. Leave varn ends long to be hidden in fringe.

Row 1: With RS facing, join A with sc, sc in end st of each row across. Fasten off. Do not turn throughout stripes.

Row 2: With RS facing, join C with dc in first st, ldc in back loop of each sc across. Fasten off.

Row 3: With RS facing, join A with dc in first st, ldc in back loop of each dc across. Fasten off.

**Rows 4-5:** With RS facing, join **B** with dc in first st, ldc in back loop of each dc across. Fasten off.

**Row 6:** With RS facing, join **A** with dc in first st, ldc in back loop of each dc across. Do not fasten off.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, skip first st, reverse sc in each dc across. Fasten off.

Turn project over and with RS facing, repeat Rows 1-7 to created stripes on the other side of the cables

## Fringe

Cut yarn 9" long, and with three strands held together add a tassle to the end of each corresponding color row.

## FINGERLESS MITTS (make 2)

With **A**, ch 44.

Row 1: Insert hook into 3rd ch from hook, yo and pull up a loop, insert hook into 4th ch from hook, yo and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice (creates first ldc). Ldc in each remaining ch across. Fasten off. Do not turn throughout Mitts - 41 ldc.

**Row 2:** With RS facing join **C** with dc in first st, Ldc in back loop of each st across. Fasten off.

Rows 3 - 18: Repeat Row 2 with changing color each row in the following order: A, B, B, A, C, A, B, A, C.

## Seaming

With RS facing line up the bottom of Row 1 with the top of Row 18, whipstitch 22 stitches from the edge going through the foundation of Row 1 and back loop of Row 18. Fasten off. Skip 10 stitches to create thumbhole, whipstitch as established the final 10 stitches. Fasten off. Weave in all loose ends.

## Thumb

**Round 1:** Join **B** with dc in any st of thumbhole, Ldc in back loops evenly around thumbhole. Do not join.

**Round 2:** Ldc in each back loop of st around. Fasten off.

## HAT

**Note:** Hat is crocheted flat then seamed to create tube. One end is cinched to create crown. Other end is crocheted around to create brim.

With **A**. ch 34.

Row 1: Insert hook into 3rd ch from hook, yo and pull up a loop, insert hook into 4th ch from hook, yo and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice (creates first ldc). Ldc in each remaining ch across. Fasten off. Do not turn throughout hat.- 31 ldc.

**Row 2:** With RS facing join Suite with dc in first st, Ldc in back loop of each st across. Fasten off.

Rows 3 - 45: Repeat Row 2 with changing color each row in the following order: A, B, B, A, C, A, B, A, C.

## Seaming

With RS facing line up the bottom of first row with the top of the last row, whipstitch going through the foundation of first row and back loop of last row across to create tube, do not fasten off. Weave in and out of ends of stripes all the way around, cinch tight and secure to create crown of hat. Fasten off.



#### Brim

**Note:** Brim is worked along edge of hat in rows, then seamed together at end.

**Row 1:** With RS facing, join **A** with sc to edge of hat. Place 131 sc evenly around edge of hat. Do not fasten off. Turn. – 132 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in back loop of each sc across. Do not fasten off. Turn

**Row 3:** Ch 2 (counts as first st), \*bpdc around next dc, fpdc around next dc; repeat from \* across, hdc in top of tch. Do not fasten off. Turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 2 (counts as first st), \*bpdc around next st, cable across next 3 st,; repeat from \* across, hdc in top of tch. Do not fasten off. Turn.

Row 5: Repeat Row 3

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**Row 6:** Ch 2 (counts as first st), \*skip next st, fpdc around next st; repeat from \*across, hdc in top of tch. Fasten off. Weave in loose ends.

With WS facing whipstitch seam of brim.
